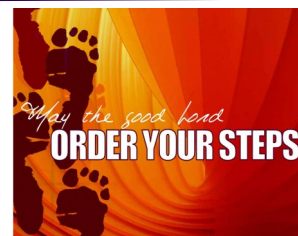

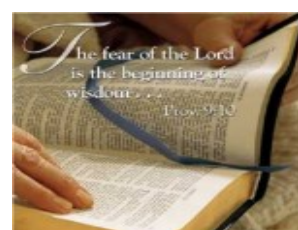

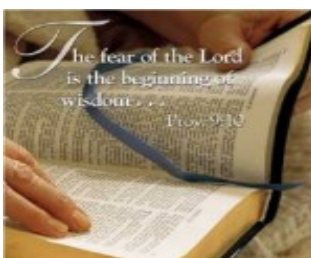

thou art mine. 2 **When** thou **passest through** the waters, I will be with thee; and **through** the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest **through** the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee. ”

Are ye not much better than they? 27 Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? 28 And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: 29 and yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. **30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?** 31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? 32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) **for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. 33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. 34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.** ”*

In all, only faith in God can dismantle the stronghold that fear has on us and then worries for clothes to put on, food to eat and drink to quench your taste will come to an end.

May you gladly receive this prophetic word of hope, faith and love to prosper through God, doing life in His grace over the spirit of fear.

I pray that Faith in God will reign supreme in your hearts and minds this month of December. I prophesy that you be of love, of sound mind and of power.

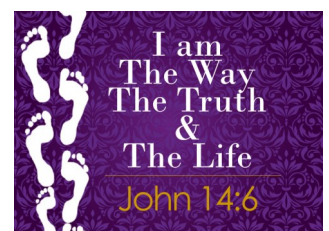

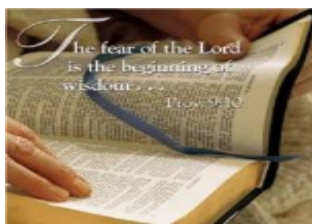

Haggai 2:6-8 *"For thus saith the LORD of hosts; yet once,*

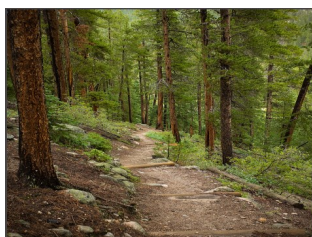

it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land; 7And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts. 8The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts."

Hence I have sectioned the word Christmas in this way on this special December-Christmas edition: 'CHRIST and MAS'. Wherefore, Christ means, the anointed One, the Messiah, the Saviour, the Holy one of Israel and the Redeemer. And 'MAS' or 'MASS' – To Celebrate, commemorate, Observe. CHRISTMAS in this context is the yearly commemoration and Celebration of God's love in the birth of Christ and His cause on Earth.

Hence, signifying the sharing of that grace and the benediction of the triune God expressed through their love to mankind as in **2 Corinthians 13:14**

For me and every supposed Spirit born child of God, what is vital in the whole scenario of indifference is that Christ was born in the flesh – humanity. Date and time should not be an issue, but the act of acknowledging this very fact and truth of God in the light of the Holy Scriptures makes the journey of the Christian FAITH meaningful to anyone that dares believe in Christ Jesus as saviour and Lord. Amen!

The scriptures as in **1 John 4:1 –3 and 1 John 5:7-12** say that any person or people who do not acclaim that Christ was born in the flesh (humanity) are the antichrist. **Jesus** means **saviour** while **Christ** means - **the Messiah, the Saviour, the anointed one and Holy one of Israel, while 'anti' means - to be against**. This indicates that such a person does not believe in Christ's virgin and humanity birth and as such becomes an enemy of JEHOVAH God.

It's also proof that such a person or group of persons have undermined the record and prophesy spoken of God in time prior to Christ's birth even as in the holy writ **-1 John 5:9-12; Isaiah 7:14; 9:6-7**. Such an individual or group, the Holy Scripture calls a fool – for the fool says in his heart there is no God. (**Psalms 14:1; Isaiah 53:1**)

Herein are some of Christ Jesus humanity experiences:

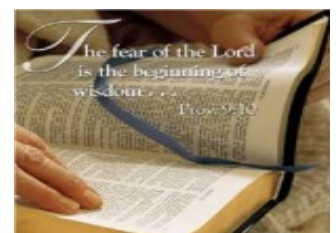

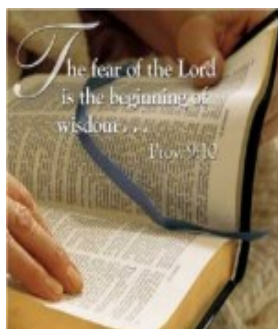
Let us celebrate him for he is born indeed; He is indeed born in our hearts and in our being. His birth is the rebirth of:

- To redeem us from the curse and effect of the law and the fall of man (**Galatians 3:13-14; Ephesians 1:7; Colos-**



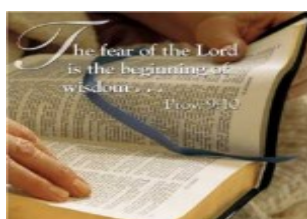

You shall be as a little Child – Mark 10:15

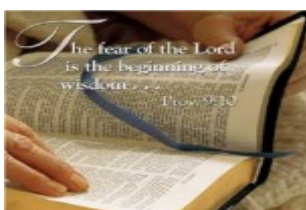

Finally: Selfishness makes Christmas a burden but love makes Christmas a peace, love and joy.



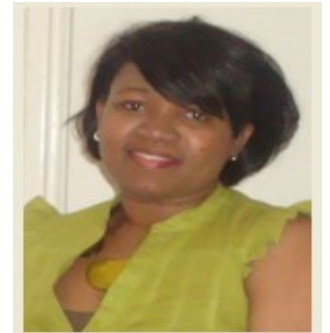

THE BERIA WAY - Know The Word For Yourself

Sometime ago I signed up for a Bible devotional with an on-line Bible. On one of the evenings I just thought to share out loud this devotional with my husband. As I got to a part about **Jonah** that linked him to **2 Kings and King Jeroboam**, - saying 'the book of 2 Kings tells of Jonah's ministry under Jeroboam II, king of Israel.'

My husband says "Wait a minute, that's not right. The story in 2 Kings 14 only refers to Jonah's ministry in verse 25 - what you just read doesn't sound completely right of Jonah's ministry."

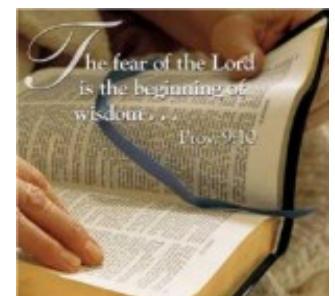
Now I don't know this. I don't know where in the scripture the story of Jonah is other than in the book of Jonah. So I had to log right on to 2 Kings and read it for myself. Set the record straight in my own mind. Just because it sounds right; just because it's coming from a reputable man of God - does not mean that it's the word.



This for me re-enforces the truth that we need to know the word for ourselves. Don't be satisfied with what you hear on the pulpit alone. Just like the **Beria Christians** did in **Acts 17:10-12** *"And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews. 11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. 12 Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few".* After you listen to these teachings and or teachings - go and search the scripture.

Paul says in **1 Corinthians 13:9-10** *"...For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away".* (NKJV)

The Word of God needs to come alive in you as you read and study, it is the revealed Word of God, that is how it works. You may read the

same passage again some time later in your life and what that speaks to you differs from what it may originally have meant for you. 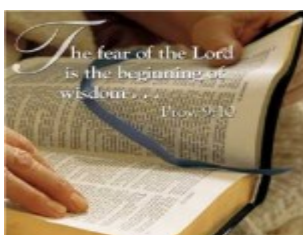
Faith pleases God. Faith is acting on the Word of God. It is acting on what you believe. You will need to know what you believe in order to act on it.

Study the Word. Know God. Fellowship with Him. Enhance your relationship with God. Don't be deceived by teaching that may sound right. With the Holy Spirit living in you, He is able to guide you and bare witness to the things that you ought to do and not to do. The more time that you spend in His presence, the more you know Him and know His voice without a doubt.

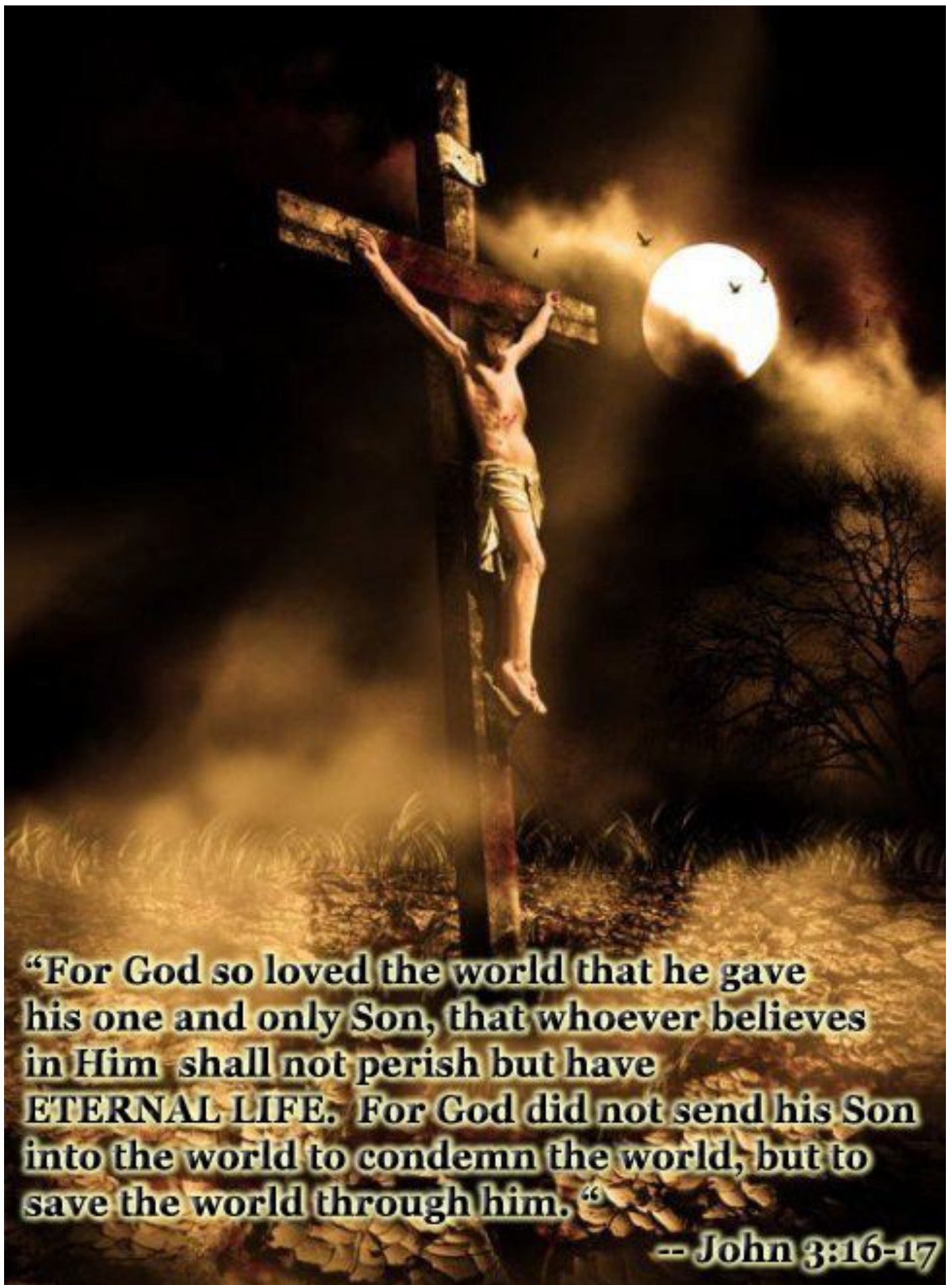
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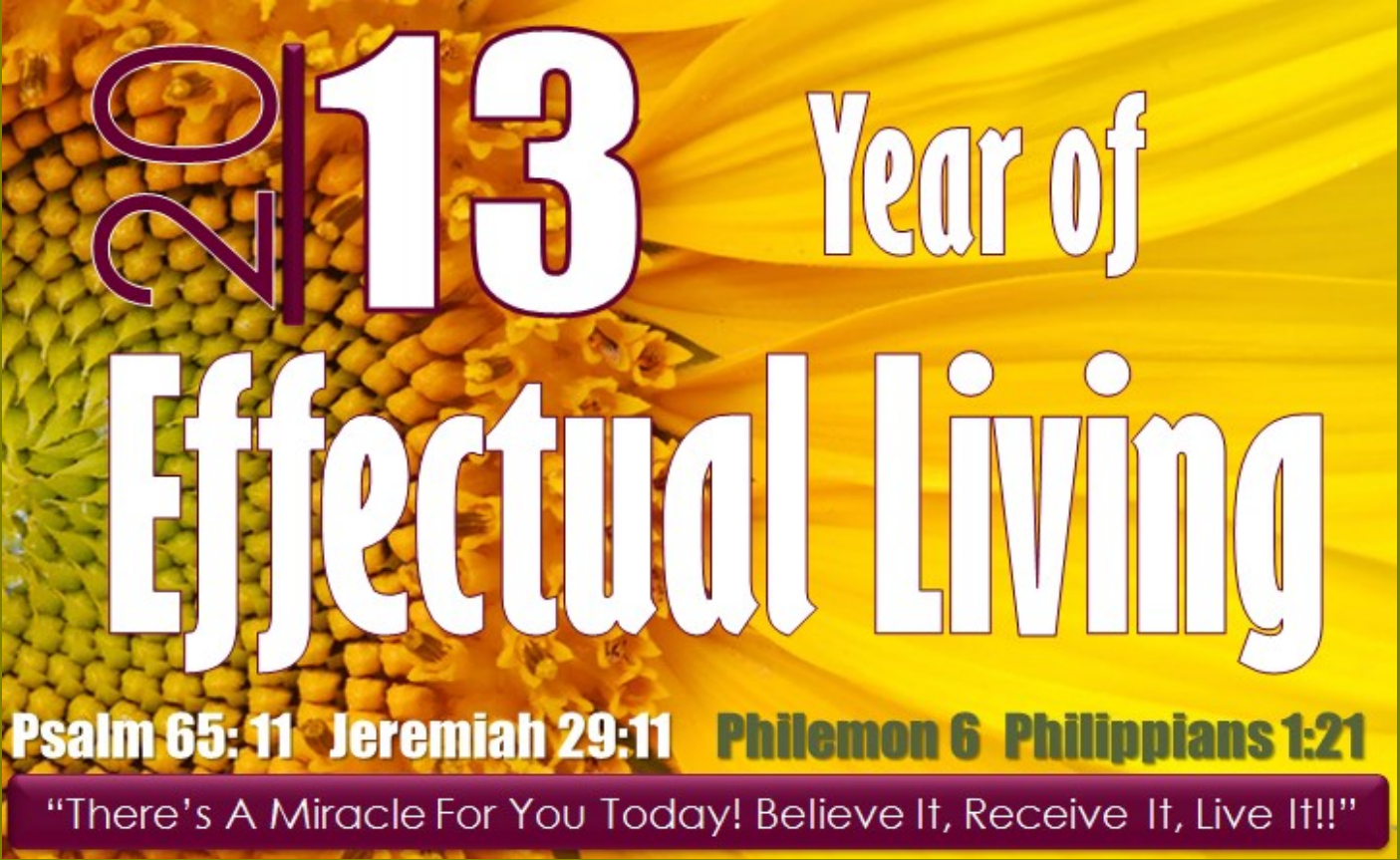
