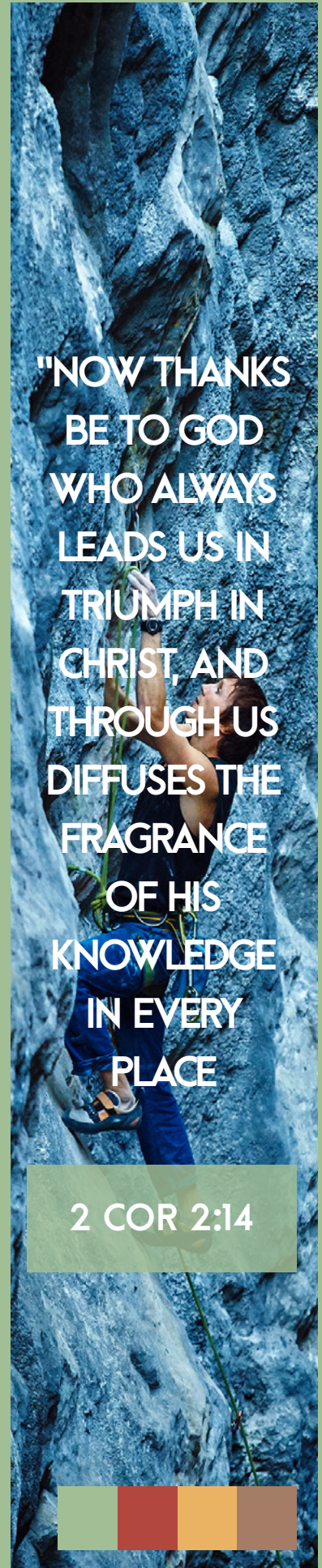

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

"THE LORD
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HABAKKUK 3:19

Firstly, I want you to know that God wants you to have and live a triumphant life. He wants you to triumph in every place that the sole of your feet will find itself. Not just in some places of your life but in every place of your life endeavours and desired goals as 2 Corinthians 2:14 assured us. A life that is victorious in all situations and circumstances. A life full of the aroma of God's knowledge in all triumph over all battles that come your way of doing life and living godly, in the light of God's eternal plan, purposes and pursuit for you and of you.

In order to endorse this great month, the good Lord has given me an assured and insured prophetic word of gracious exhortation for you and all, in this month of September and onwards. It's taken from the scriptural reading:

Psalms 18:33 "It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect. He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places"(Psalms 18).

Habakkuk 3:19 "Although the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat; the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls: 18 Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation. 19 The Lord God is my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' feet, and he will make me to walk upon mine high places . . ."

Joshua 1:1-3 ". . . Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses."

2 Corinthians 2:14 "Now thanks be unto God, which always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place."

God would love you to know that every place that the sole of your foot treads upon shall be for your possession, and that He has given it to you to rule and to reign over it, as Joshua 1:1-3, Romans 5:17, 21 and Psalms 110:1-3 assure us. Just as Habakkuk declared in the 17th to the 19th verses of the 3rd chapter – we too can declare that, whatever happens I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in the God of my salvation. Habakkuk spoke of many circumstances; that even though the fig trees had no blossom, no grapes on the vines, the olive crops failed, the fields were empty and barren, there was death of flocks – he would still

rejoice in the Lord, he would be joyful in the God of His salvation.

Habakkuk says that the Lord God is his strength, that He gives him the speed of a deer – a sure-footed deer – that is able to tread upon the heights triumphantly. The feet of a sure-footed deer would enable you to overcome, all your mountains, valleys, crooked roads and rough places with dignity and graciousness. God is faithful to see you triumph according to Isaiah 40:3-5 and 1 Corinthians 1:9 and Hebrews 10:23.

You will not let circumstances deter you or define you, but you will dare to make triumph out of every situation in faith of what God has done in you by Christ Jesus. This means that whatever it is that you endeavour to do, as you dare to take a step of faith, you shall have it in peace and tranquillity with God. He will do it such that thanksgiving of this triumph will become your day to day song to His glory and praise. It is the triumph of beauty in place of ashes, oil of joy in the places of mourning and the garment of praise in the midst of the spirit of heaviness; while being called the trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified as the scripture of Isaiah 61:1-3 enjoins.

I pray that as you turn into this month of September, being the night of the year, that it shall be the beginning of triumph and a victorious testimony for you. A month in which you will live victoriously and reign triumphantly in all of life's endeavours; where all things are under your control while you walk in the path of dominion wherein Christ had made you free. Amen!

Finally, our God gives you the hind's feet, the high heels acclaimed as the sure-footed deer. May He by it set you up, upon your desired endeavours and high place goals for His glory and your blessings according to Psalms 18:32-33 and 2 Samuel 22:34 and Habakkuk 3:17-19. May this ninth (9th) month of the year turn your shame to fame, your disdain to honour and glory, your failures to success, your setbacks to stepping stones, and your disappointments to appointments. I declare that the good Lord becomes your song in triumph and victory even as sang by Moses and Mariam as in Exodus 15:1-21.

“... 11 Who is like unto thee, O Lord, among the gods? who is like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders? ... 20 And Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. 21 And Miriam answered them, Sing ye to the Lord, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.”

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PREAMBLE

HINDS FEET - Being Sure-footed As A DEER!

Triumph is the perception and feeling of great happiness resulting from a victory or major achievement. It also means the act and condition of being victorious, a winner, prosperous and more importantly, being at rest and peace with oneself and being a more than conqueror in all life endeavours in spite of all.

Mountains are known to be steep and dangerous. The Deer is an animal that is able to manoeuvre the steep and dangerous mountains in order to get to the high places that they need to get to. In life there is steepness, danger, wickedness, challenges and more. When one dares to take a step of faith to those high places of graciousness, these can be surmountable.

Sometimes life may seem unfair when a few making it yet some struggle on the day to day issues of life. The good news for you today and for this month is that God wants you to make it and He has provided for you, feet like hinds' feet to get you to a place that you earnestly desire.

God wants you to triumph in life, but you have to take a step of faith and dare all things that have limited you by the deeds of Christ in you. It is the daring spirit that succeeds by the done deeds of Christ in you; that makes one to triumph in every place and be set up on their desired high places as set out by God from the beginning as in Jeremiah 17:12

"A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary"

God has not given us the spirit of limitation, of fear, of intimidation, or inferiority complex, or of no confidence; but He has given us the Spirit of boldness, power, sound mind and love to enable us to dare to triumph over every mountain, valley, crooked road and rough place that oppose to our high places of dignity and honour in Christ and in life. This is what the timeless word says about you in 2 Timothy 1:7.

"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power (boldness), and of love, and of a sound mind" (emphasis mine)

Hence each year in September, especially since the first





publication of the AFD Teaching Newsletter publication ten years ago, I am reminded of three important things. Firstly, my natural and spiritual birthdays are in September, making it a very special month for me. Secondly, because it is the ninth (9th) month of the year signifying perfection, wholeness, completeness, maturity and such likes. Thirdly, since there are nine spiritual fruit and nine spiritual gifts of the Holy Spirit, it thus speaks as a month of character, integrity and prudence as regards to the spiritual fruit enjoined in Galatians 5:22-23 and also of inspiration, revelation and empowerment as to the spiritual gifts and ministerial gifting's as stipulated in 1 Corinthians 12:4-11).

However, some may have a very weird philosophy in thinking or imagining this month like those who have no hope and faith that it is the beginning of BER or MBER months, such as - September, October, November and December – it thus mean to them the start of a bad omen and trouble or crises.

Whatever your stand may be at the moment, know that it is on this basis of life endeavours that God wants you to triumph whatever the odds. It is the month in which he wants to make you complete, established, whole, settled and perfected by the Holy Spirit spiritual gifts, gifting's and the fruit as enacted in 1 Peter 5:10.

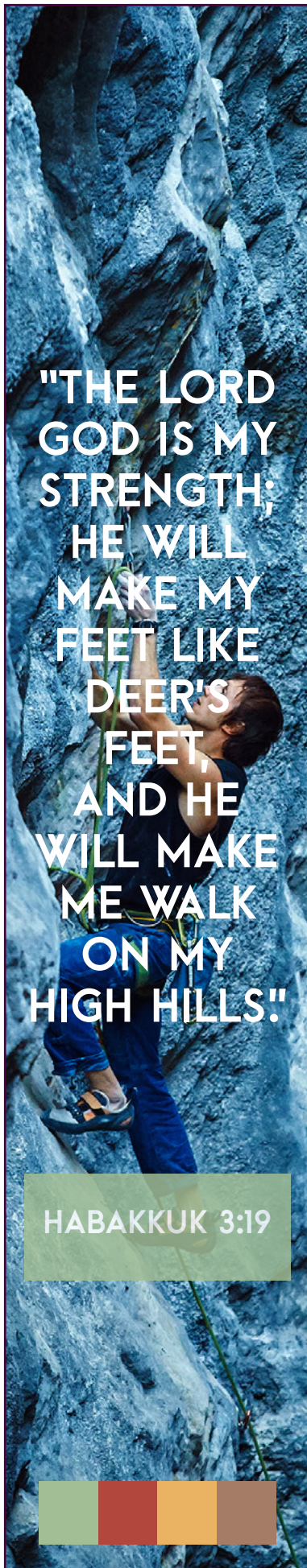
"But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, establish, strengthen, settle you."

It is God's will that you triumph in every endeavour. You are the reason the earth was created (Psalms 8:3-8;

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Isaiah 45:11-13) and the cause for which Christ died, was buried and resurrected. It was for a new you with the seal of triumph, victory, more than a conqueror, overcomer and prosperity or success on it as endorsed by these scriptures for a start - 2 Corinthians 2:14; 1 Corinthians 15:57; Romans 8:37; 3 John 2 and Joshua 1:8.

Knowing full well that God wants you to achieve well, I am hoping with trust in God that this SEPTEMBER 2020 EDITION – 'Dare To Triumph In Every Place' – will grant you along with other achievers the enabling grace and leverage to dare to triumph in all that you desire and trust God to bring about in your life in every place. Especially in dealing and triumphing over all the setbacks and fears of becoming or achieving the craved high places, the desired goals, aspirations and dreams in your life which pertain to doing life and godly living as enjoined, promised and empowered to us in the following scriptural truth:

Hebrews 6:10-12 "For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister. 11 And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: 12 that ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises."

2 Peter 1:1-4 "Simon Peter, a bondservant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."



IN THE KNOWLEDGE OF CHRIST

DARE TO TRIUMPH IN EVERY PLACE

2 Corinthians 2:14 "Now thanks be unto God, which always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place."

2 Peter 1:1-4 "... 2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

John 17:2-3 "As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. 3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent."

Philippians 3:10 "That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death"

Daniel 11:32b "... but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits."

Psalms 9:10 "And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, Lord, hast not forsaken them that seek thee."

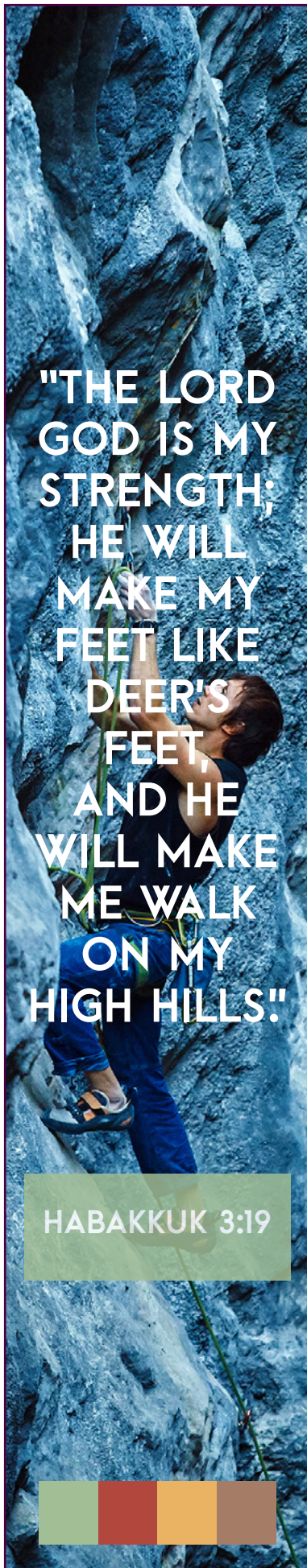
Philemon 6 "That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus."

More importantly, in order to dare to triumph in every place in Christ, one needs to get to know the Christ of the triumph rather than just the triumph. Apostle Paul writing to the Corinthians stated that the manifestation in every place is by the knowing of Christ not just knowing about Christ. Otherwise, it becomes like the children of Israel who knew only the miracles of God through Moses and never knew the God of Moses, the God of the miracles. No wonder God made His ways known to Moses only while the miracle was known only to the children of Israel as stated in *Psalms 103:7*.

"He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel."

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In order to dare to triumph in every place, acknowledge the person of Christ in all your plans. When life challenges come in the process, the Lord can defend the cause of that endeavour. For the Lord will only commend what He commands – Proverbs 16:1-3, 7, 9; Psalms 37:3-6. The essence of Redemption for your triumph in the knowledge of Christ is summed up in these three:

1. TRIUMPH OVER SICKNESS

2. TRIUMPH OVER POVERTY

3. TRIUMPH OVER SPIRITUAL DEATH

These acts of triumph are as a result of who we are in God through the acknowledgement of what Christ is, what He has become to us, with us, for us and has done in us in redemption acts and process. For Christ Jesus has become our Wisdom, Righteousness, Sanctification and Redemption in God-head bodily as regards to our triumph and dominions even as these scriptures enjoined us to know. - 1 John 4:4; Philemon 6 and 1 Corinthians 1:30.

Hence to assure and ensure that we dare live to triumph in every place, Jesus endorsed a deal with the Father God in His great High-Priestly ministry in the prayer of John 17:2-3. He specifically mentioned that God will cause us to know Him as the only true God and Jesus Christ whom He sent, for in that is eternal life. The life of God, 'ZOE' in Greek, is more than enough to give us the necessary leverage to dare to triumph in Him.

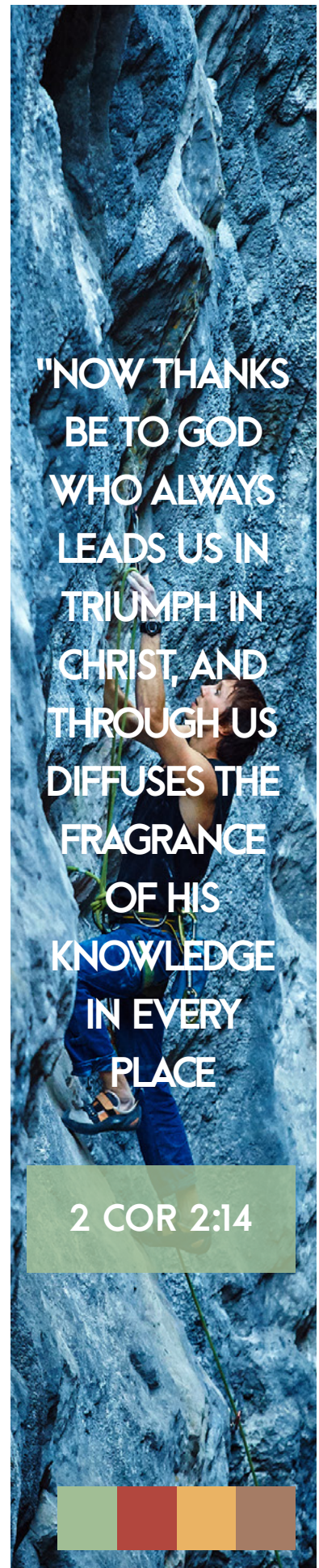
More or less the kingdom way of doing life and triumphing in every place is because the Father God is involved through Jesus Christ to partner with us in order to succeed. It is also for this knowing that Apostle Paul, despite his entire exploits in the kingdom for good with established churches as in his CV, and the revelation of grace upon his life, will always acclaim that he wants to know Christ more and more as in Philippians 3:10. Apostle Paul knew that having the knowledge of Christ will always cause him to dare to triumph in every place with thanksgiving. Hence he craved to know Him indeed.

In the same context Apostle Peter writing in 2 Peter 1:1-4, indicated that all things that pertain to life and godliness as a result of God's power is accessed through the knowledge of Christ who has brought us to a place of glory and virtue – which is goodness; This means that the knowing of Him is the route to understanding the magnitude, the multi-faceted and multi-dimensional side that brought about the endowed grace of

blessings available for us all in God, to access and possess as our inheritance in Christ Jesus.

Psalms 9:10 and Daniel 11:32 make it easy for us to know that when we know God and His Christ, we will put our trust in them absolutely without doubt; leading us to the place of triumph and we can then do exploits in all that pertains to doing life and living godly. There is always the need to acknowledge God and His Christ by the working of the Holy Spirit if one will live triumphantly in all life endeavours. This is what Apostle Paul writing in Philemon 6 helps to illuminate. We are as triumphant and as victorious by the acknowledgement of what Christ is and He has done in us; which will make our faith effectual and effective in life.

When we know the God of Triumph through the knowledge of Christ and not through creed, man-made doctrinal dogmas and such likes, we will experience the tremendous triumph and victory that God gives to those that know Him in all of our life endeavours. The knowledge of Christs' deeds in us gives the right to the hinds' feet to set us in high places as in Psalm 18:32-33 "It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect. He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places"





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IT'S GOD'S PROMISE IN HIS WORD

DARE TO TRIUMPH IN EVERY PLACE

2 Corinthians 2:14 "Now thanks be unto God, which always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place."

Luke 10:17-20 "17 Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, 'Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.' 18 And He said to them, 'I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.'"

Matthew 28:18-20 "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen."

Mark 16:15-20 "And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen."

1 Corinthians 15:57 "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Triumph is the perception and feeling of great happiness resulting from a major achievement. It also means the act and condition of being victorious from a challenging and difficult task. To triumph, succeed, win and prosper is the promised of God. It is within you to let it be or not. It is your choice to appropriate it and make it real or not. Choose not to fail in the midst of gracious opportunities in God. There is no kingdom regard for

anyone who chooses to triumph by any means that undermines the integrity, authority and authenticity of God's Word in their life.

I have come to know that when people succeed or fail they talk about it. I find that some Christians in wanting not to stand out in Faith, in order to be accepted and to avoid being seen as wanting to be "holier-than-thou", - would rather speak about the negative in their lives. When the world says, I'm broke, I'm ill, times are hard – you need to choose to speak forth what the Word of God says instead. Choose to achieve and succeed in life as the scriptures compel all to achieve and succeed because our God is an achiever. It is a fact that in course of life there may be times of challenges, but the truth of life is that your triumph in every place is the promise of God to all according the holy writ of 2 Corinthians 2:14, 1 Corinthians 15:57 and Matthew 28:20b.

Jesus gave a command and not advice for great achievement and success. He promised to be there until we surely triumph. We see it in the scriptures that as the disciples – which also we are by His grace – who later become apostles, that as they walk in obedience, they achieve triumphantly and victoriously. The Lord was with them in every place, where they went, working with them and accompanying their doings with miraculous signs - Isaiah 1:19; Luke 10:17-20; Mark 16:15-20. They triumph in every place, be it in private or public life, good times and challenging time, in and out of prison.

In a similar scenario we find it in God's promise to Joshua of Old as he leads the children of Israel in all their life battles to the Promised Land - Joshua 1:1-4.

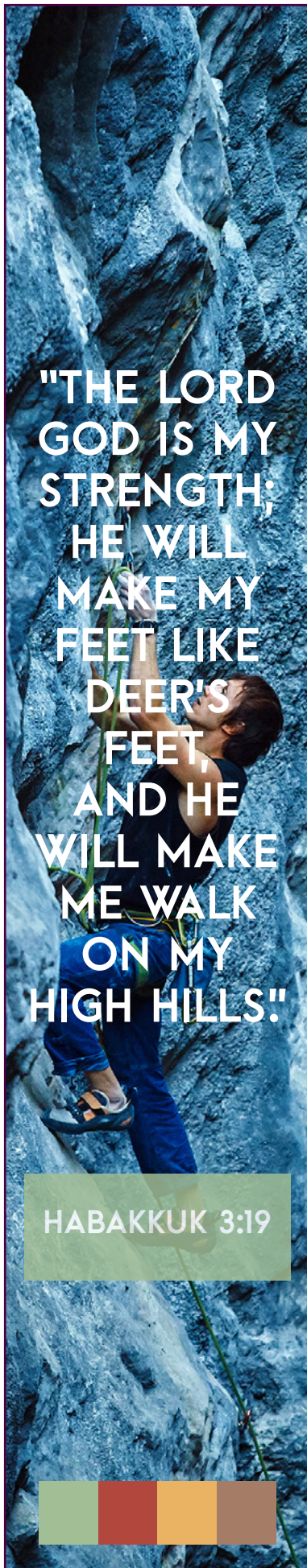
"... the LORD spoke unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying . . . now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel. . . Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you . . . From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast."

It was this kind of knowledge that Apostle Paul, writing to the Corinthian Church in 2 Corinthians 2:14, indicated that TRIUMPH in EVERY PLACE is God's intention in Christ Jesus for all. Apostle Peter said the same in Acts 10:34-36.

"... In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. 35 But in

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every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him. 36 The word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ, He is Lord of all”.

When you gave your life to Christ, a new spiritual DNA default was implanted or engrafted into you – hence you are called a new creation – 2 Corinthian 5:17; Galatians 6:14-15. The old life default of defeat, failure and regret consciousness, setback mentality and such like was completely washed and cleansed away and a new redemption default of triumph, victory, success and such like was then downloaded and transferred into your triune being – 1Thessalonians 5:23; Colossians 1:13-14; Ephesians 1:7-8.



I challenge you to consistently run the TRIUMPH in EVERY PLACE browser as your DEFAULT in every aspect of your life. By doing this, you triumph over all that you set your feet on, just like Joshua in Joshua 1:3-4. You activate your FAITH in order to become an ACHIEVER, creating an opportunity and avenue of greatness by the act of enacting a triumph default consciousness.

Triumph need not be a wish but a deliberate resolution and defined plan, purpose and pursuit of God from when Adam fell until Christ came for all mankind. Triumph is not a wish but a calculated, designed and arranged plan of God for you. But if you are going about browsing the default of failure, defeat, pity, complain, murmuring, nagging, setbacks and such like, you can't live triumphantly in the redemption plan, purpose and pursuit of God for you.

There is food for thought for which I want you to really think through and consider here: Do you want to live in the consciousness of being a victor, a winner, and a success! Or do you want to live in the consciousness of yesterday's failures, mistakes, defeat, setbacks and as being an under-achiever? Are your conscious

acts in all life endeavours as a result of the knowledge of Christ and God's sayings or of other sources? Is God's word your default browser or is it what you get in the media – television newscast, newspapers publications, and the internet cum social media, family traditions, society norms and self-belief. Are they your default browser? Is it your spouse, parents or children or friends whose browser is your default? Think about it!

Until one makes God's word in the knowledge of Christ a conscious default browser in their daily life, TRIUMPH in every place will be eluded. It is a choice to live all your life complaining, murmuring and blaming people and circumstances for your limitations. It is also a choice to arise in grace and faith and shine out your God given light in the awesome, amazing and majestic beauty of the glorious plan of God; for you to triumph every day, in everyplace, as inscribed and ascribed in the following scriptural truths.

Jeremiah 17:12. "A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary."

Jeremiah 29:11 - "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope."

IT'S IN YOUR DNA IN CHRIST DARE TO TRIUMPH IN EVERY PLACE

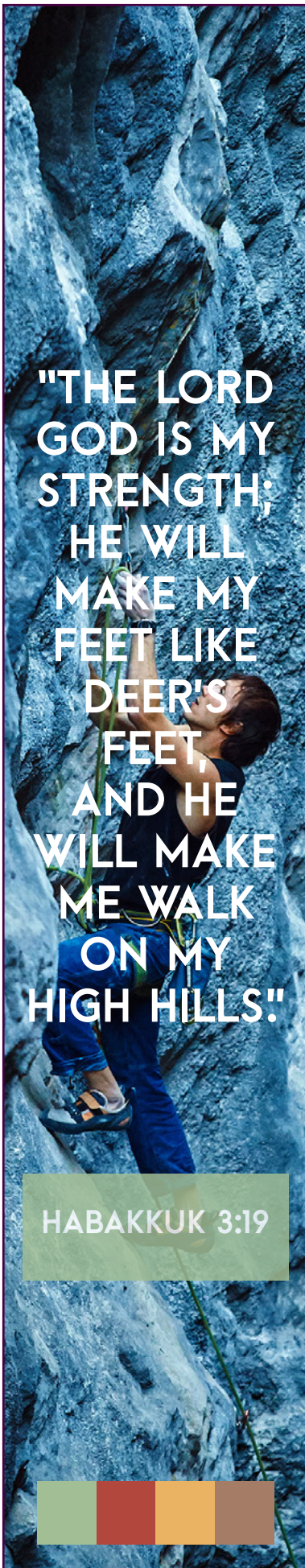
2 Corinthian 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

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HABAKKUK 3:19



The term DNA - "Deoxyribonucleic Acid" - speaks of genetics. This is the main constituent or component of the chromosomes of all organisms, and is the material that transfers genetic characteristics in all life forms - like for like".

People will make comments like – I am behaving in this way because it's in my blood or DNA and it runs in the family. Meaning to them if one is poor, the likelihood is that all will or may be poor in the family no matter how much they try to make a difference. If one died young or through a mysterious or deadly disease or by car accident, that all may likely die in the same ways; as to them it runs in the family.

"This kind of notion becomes a great worry when you hear a supposedly redeemed born again child of God making similar statements when they are in crisis or facing some difficult challenges of health and otherwise".

It is irrelevant whether or not you have a family history of divorce, cancerous diseases, childlessness, late marriages, poverty, never-do-well and many such likes, the day you gave your life to Jesus, a new you for a new dawn was born and began to come to be. The scriptures say in 2 Corinthians 5:17 and Galatians 6:14-15 and 2 Corinthians 2:14 that if any man comes to Christ, such becomes a new personality, the old personality and Adamic family history default is gone, a new you is in Christ Jesus. There is a spiritual exchange which takes place as a result of that simple act of being born of God.

It is for this that in the epistles writings that the apostles for example will start in their writings in a particular formats or manner as shown in *2 Corinthians 1:1, Colossians 1:1, Ephesians 1:1, Philippians 1:1, 1 Peter 1:1, James 1:1 and Jude 1* etc. That



is, by identifying their place and our place in God, using the phrase 'of Christ' or 'of Jesus' or 'of Jesus Christ'. The use of the word "of" indicates a new DNA as the default at work in their life and our life in Christ Jesus. Hence they were assured, ensured and insured to have triumph in life and ministry and don't need any special pilgrimage because it is of faith in their spirit by the Holy Spirit through God's Word. This helps to indicate why the apostles did not reckon their knowledge of Christ - humanly - as most people would have loved to do religiously as indicated in – *2 Corinthians 5:16*.

"Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more."

In the same spirit as that of the apostles, I want you to know that by coming into the beloved family of God, your life was redeemed, translated and transformed into the image of Christ in order to triumph in every place – the valleys, mountains, hills, crooked roads and rough places of life - (*Galatians 3:13-14; Colossians 1:13-14; Isaiah 40:3-5*). Now that you are born of God, you have a new identity and the power to put an end to the enemy's intended plan in your life and family. You need to devolve yourself of the past and develop a new consciousness of triumph mentality as a transformed child of God. You need to renew your mind as indicated in the scriptures below:

Romans 12:1-2 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

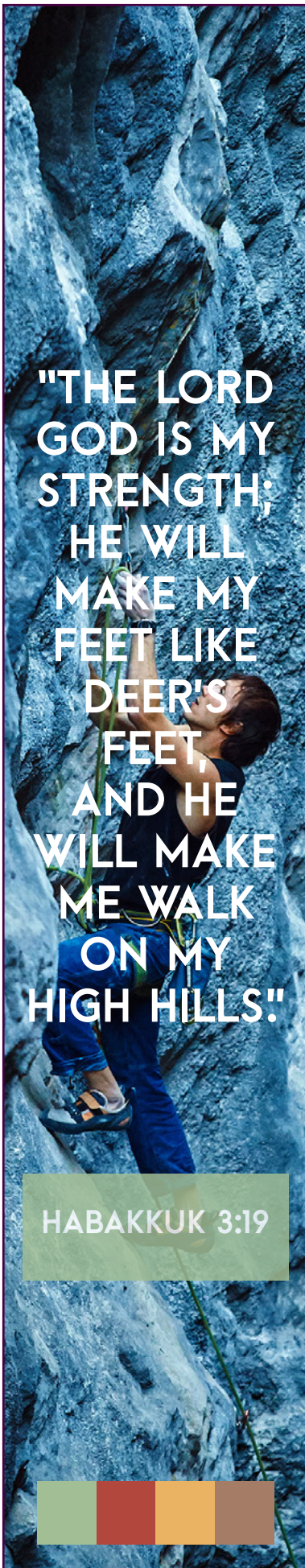
Ephesians 4:22-24 "That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind; 24 and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness."

Now that you are in Christ, you have to reprogram your life's browser into a new default by the word of God. Your FAITH on your new DNA determines your triumph in life as it says in 1 John 5:4-5.

"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our

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FAITH. *Who is he that OVERCOMETH the world, but he that BELIEVETH that Jesus is the Son of God".*

In God's browser, the default of FAITH enables you to triumph, live victoriously and overcome in challenges no matter how tense the matter may be. I believe that you can end that family history of setback, fear, limitations, abuse, divorce, poverty and laziness and such likes, by inclining to God's default browser which enables you to win and triumph in every place in life. For you can now do all things through Christ – DNA default – that strengthens you as says in Philippians 4:13.

For your DNA of triumph is as a result of the done deed in the blood of the Lamb – Lord Jesus Christ – Amen!

IN YOUR TRIUNE BEING: SPIRIT, SOUL & BODY

division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."

The preceding scriptures remind us that man is a tripartite being - meaning he is a spirit being, has a soul and lives in a body. This means that - Man is a spirit being, he has a soul (the consciousness of the mind or intellect, emotion and will) and lives in humus - that is the body - 1 Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 4:12-13. The body which is humus is subject to metamorphosis including death. The man that is in the body - humus - which makes man a hu-man being is firstly spirit and spiritual. It lives by the breath of God unlike the body that lives by oxygen.

The good Lord wants you to triumph totally, wholly and completely in your being - spirit, soul and body - that is, being blamelessly preserved awaiting the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, amen. It's not of God that you are doing very well in your spirit but dying in your body and insane in your mind, that is, the faculty of reasoning and intellect in your soul. Herein are some guidelines to triumphing in your tripartite being:

TRIUMPH IN YOUR SPIRIT

Our spirit is our link of breath and life in the Holy Spirit to God by the Word of God. Hence, when our spirit is disturbed we are traumatised as in the following scriptures:

Job 32:8 "But there is a spirit in man, and the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding.

Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life."

John 4:24 "God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth."

Proverbs 18:14 "The spirit of a man will sustain him in sickness (Infirmity), but who can bear a broken spirit?"

Proverbs 20:27 "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching the inward parts of the belly"

When we were saved, we were born again in our spirit, but our soul and body remained more or less unchanged. Our spirit was reborn into the Kingdom and life of God - ZOE (Greek). To

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function and triumph effectively in that realm, we would need to be mature and grow up in the way that the word directs us to – Hebrews 5:11-14; 1 Peter 2:1-3.

Since God is a Spirit, we can only contact, relate and reach out to Him with our human spirit being via the indwelling Holy Spirit - John 4:21-24; John 14:16-17. Hence, there is the need for our spiritual growth and development in order to live a triumphant life in every place. One can't afford to remain a baby and an apparent novice in spiritual things. See these scriptures for more references- John 3:1-8, John 7:37-39, Romans 2:28-29, 1 Corinthians 14:14-18, Jn. 4:21-24. Now I want you to start thinking of yourself in a new light. Don't only think yourself as just a mere physical being. Think of yourself as a spiritual being that possesses a soul and lives in a body.

Man's spirit is that part of him that contacts, relates and has communion with God. He is in the same class with God because God is a Spirit and God made man to fellowship with Him as a little god in his spirit being. See John 4:22-24; John 10:34-35 and Psalm 82:6. Man is a threefold being; the Bible teaches that man is a spirit, he has a soul and lives in a body – 1 Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 4:12. Through the spirit, we are able to contact, sense, perceive and relate to spiritual things of God as his candle light as in Proverbs 20:27; 1 Corinthians 2:9-16.

We cannot touch God physically, He is a Spirit being and we cannot communicate with God mentally, but we can reach Him with our spirit through fellowship and worship. – John 4:21-24, Philippians 3:3, Psalms 16:11, 1 Corinthians 1:9, 1 John 1:5-10. It is on this note that Proverbs 18:14 says that only by our human spirit-being in fellowship with God that we can sustain our being in all life endeavours challenges, and if there is a broken spirit as a result of life affairs it will crumble our being if not set to triumph.

TRIUMPH IN YOUR SOUL

1 Thessalonians 5:23 "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Romans 12:1-2 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice,

holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

1 Peter 1:22 "Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:"

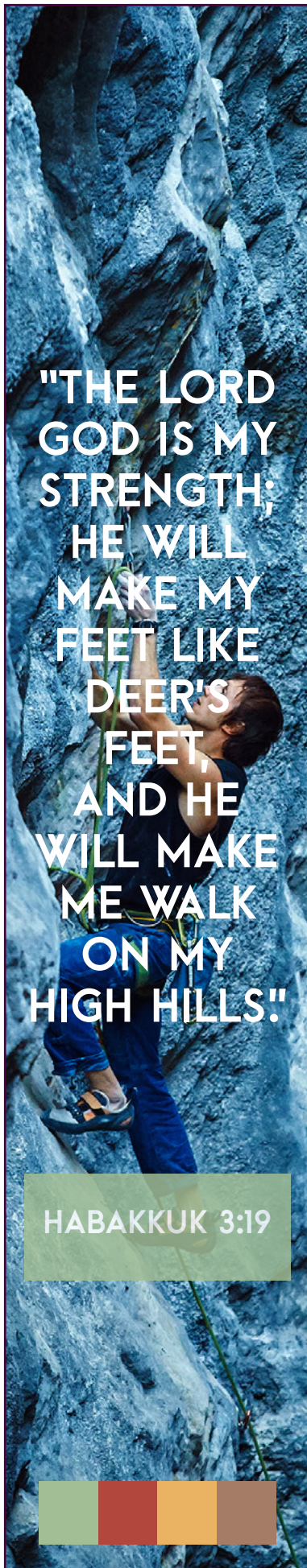
Ephesians 4:17-25 "This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, 18Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: 19Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. 20But ye have not so learned Christ; 21If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: 22That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; 24And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. 25Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another".



A human soul consists of his will, emotions and mind or intellect. Looking closely now on how to triumph in the Human Soul, the scriptures provide for us every avenue on how to triumph wholly and completely. As it was stated earlier, the Human Soul is the seat of intellect and reasoning. It has to do with man's sensibilities and will. It is the part of man that reasons and thinks. This is not "Soul travel" or "mind reading" as practiced in Grail message or ECK, Rosicrucian order, Yoga or Magician acts of sorcery or sooth-saying and or by any other such demonic acts and agents of darkness. The Scriptures say;

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"And be not conformed to this world but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God" – Romans 12:2.

Man is a tripartite (tri-une) or three fold being, the Bible teaches that man is a spirit, he has a soul and he lives in a body – 1 Thessalonians 5:23. Through the human spirit we are able to contact spiritual things -

Proverbs 20:27 "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching the inward parts of the belly".

Through the human body we contact the physical things that are all around us. Through the human soul we contact the mental things or intellectual things. This is the part we are dealing with in this context. It is the soul that reasons and thinks.

In Romans 12:2, Paul writing to the believers, made it clear that the Christian concerned needed to do something about his mind. In verse 1, He says the Christians need to do something about their bodies. The reason why this is so, is because the body and the soul have not been Born Again at the time of being saved in Christ Jesus. It is only the spirit man that is transformed at the new birth. The moment you are born again the greatest need is for you as a new creation to begin to renew your mind or your thinking process or faculties so that it can align with the authenticity of Word of God.

Looking at our Romans 12:1-2 texts properly, we notice the last part used the word 'Renewing' (present tense continuous). Renewing your mind will enable you to articulate what is that good, acceptable and perfect will of God concerning us in Christ Jesus; or in the knowledge of Christ Jesus. This understanding will cause one to triumph in every place of reasoning in making wise decisions. If you want to triumph in your human soul, that is, if you want to know what it is that is good will of God, then, renew your mind with the Word of God. It pays, it doesn't cost. If you want to know what it is that is acceptable will of God, then, renew your mind with the Word of God. If you want to know what that perfect will of God is, you need to renew your mind with the Word of God. You need to cautiously and continuously renew your mind in and by the word of God for effectual and efficient triumphant living and doing life in the kingdom.

TRIUMPH IN YOUR BODY

1 Thessalonians 5:23 "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Romans 12:1-2 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."

Romans 6:6 "knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin."

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh (body) I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me"

1 Peter 2:5, 11 "you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ . . . 11 Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul"

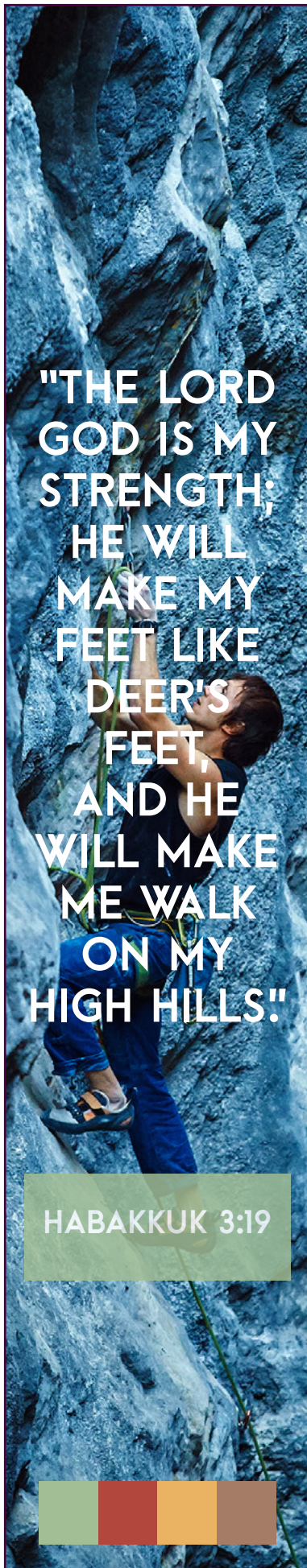
1 Corinthians 6:20 "For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's"

The human body is the outward man, the physical house in which the real man lives "I beseech you therefore, brethren by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service" - Romans 12:1. Apostle Paul was writing to the Brethren in Rome, not unbelievers, for he said I beseech you therefore, Brethren - meaning beloved of God as saints - Romans 1:7. He said that there should be need for us to do something with our bodies, to present our bodies a living sacrifice. Apostle Paul is saying that we have to do something with our bodies unto God and not the other way round.

Indeed, we have to do something with our bodies by ourselves as the caretaker of the house. We ourselves must present our bodies as a "living sacrifice, holy acceptable unto God, which is

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your reasonable service", another Bible translation said, "Which is our Spirit service."

To present your body may mean giving up your body by subjecting it to fasting and praying; it may mean to take it to Church or to that conference that you might hear the Word of God that can build your faith and spirit-being to God; it may mean sitting the body down to hear and listen to the word of God instead of wandering about, unwilling to settle and being overcome with many distractions during the course of church services; instead of a resolute decision not to be distracted in thought of mind or by others or things so that you may hear or listen to the gospel truth. It could be in your home also, subjecting it so that you can read and study instead of the media format distractions of Television or Internet - interactive social media or some special programs or other activities in the home; and many more of such-likes.

There are those who say, "Well, it doesn't make any difference about the body or what it does. This old body isn't going to heaven anyway". But it does make a difference to God what we do with our bodies. He wants transfigured and triumphant bodies, He wants us to present our bodies a living sacrifice which is our reasonable service', and it is our prerogative to present our body; and we being a new creation the Lord God wants our body to be blamelessly preserved until the coming of our Saviour-Lord, Jesus Christ. Apostle Paul said, "Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things have become new" – 2 Corinthians 5:17, 1 Corinthians 6:20; 1 Thessalonians 5:23.

This new man that we have become in Christ should dominate our thinking processes and should dominate our body for triumph. Yet many who are born again and even filled with the Holy Spirit per se are still baby Christians and have not developed spiritually. The Corinthian Church were born again people of God. They had received the Holy Spirit and gifts of the spirit were manifested among them, yet Apostle Paul reproved them for being baby Christians: He said of them: "Ye come behind in no gift" – 1 Corinthians 1:7. But still they were carnal – 1 Corinthians 3:1-23, 5:1-13. (Note: not natural or unregenerated sinners). They were baby Christians. However, baby Christians can have spiritual gifts as well as the mature Christians, as Paul stated here. Spiritual gifts don't make one a fully developed Christian but the fruit does, which is the character builder – Galatians 5:22-25. We have to grow. Baby Christians are the result of their salvation experience and their experience of being baptised in

the Holy Ghost has not yet affected their bodies and their mind. As we mentioned, earlier, the Bible tells that we ourselves must do something with our mind as well as our body, "Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God which is our reasonable service" – Romans 12:1.

When we are born of God and have the Life of God in us, then the Holy Spirit comes in to fill us and to help us. He is our Helper. He will help us to present our bodies to God as a living sacrifice. But He expects us to do something with our bodies, to present them to Him as "a living sacrifice . . ." – Romans 12:1, 1 Corinthians 6:20. He expects us to have control and triumph over our bodies and not let them dominate us. He does not want us to be carnal Christians or body-ruled Christians. God expected us to do as Apostle Paul would and said in – 1 Corinthians 9:27.

"But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway".

The choice is ours. We can let our bodies continue to dominate us if we want. If we let it, it will want to go on doing the things it has always done, or we can choose to keep our body under control and triumph over the dictates of the flesh. Our inward man can dominate it and present it to God, as a living sacrifice of the good, acceptable and perfect will of God.

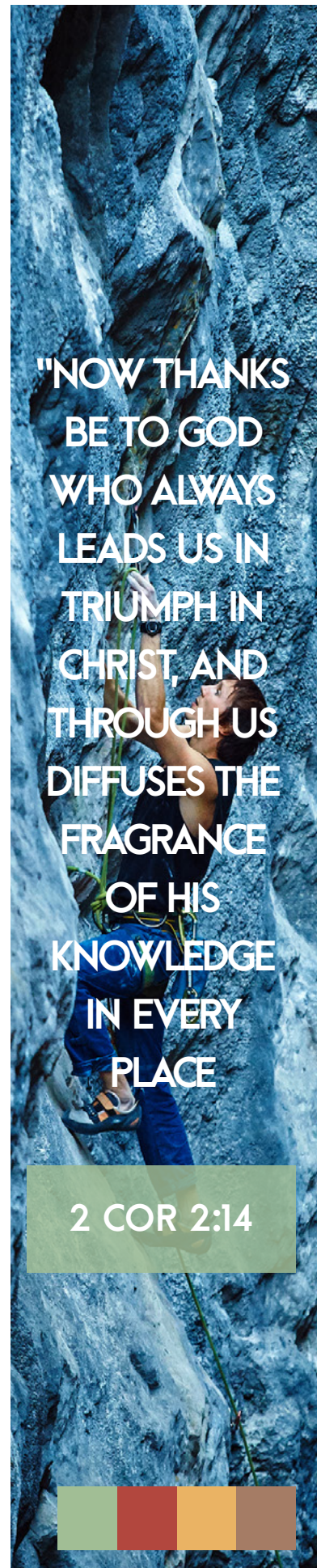
We can therefore conclude with what Apostle Paul enjoined and said with the following Scriptures:

2 Corinthians 7:1-3 "Having therefore, these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God – received us, we have wronged no man, we have corrupted no man, we have defrauded no man – I speak not this to condemn you I have said before, that ye are in our hearts to die and live with you".

Galatians 5:1, 13 "Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage . . . 13For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another"

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IN FOUR DIMENSIONS

DARE TO TRIUMPH IN EVERY PLACE

Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men."

Psalms 16:11 "You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

His understanding is unsearchable. 29 He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength. 30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, 31 But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint."

Acts 24:16 "16 And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void to offence toward God, and toward men."

James 1:5 "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraided not; and it shall be given him. 6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. 8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways."

In Luke 2:52 we see the four dimensions in which Christ grew and became in humanity. This indicates the dimensions through which we can respond to life outside our triune being as discussed earlier. These are what I call the Christ triumph dimensions. They are the dimensions of increase, to win, to achieve, to overcome, to break through and triumph in every place which He accomplished in humanity. There are four dimensions of life applications drawn from the example of our Lord Jesus Christ in humanity, which is foretaste to us:



SPIRITUALLY

Christ was in favour with God, hence God reaffirmed Him as His beloved Son, in whom he was well pleased, hear Him, again and again. The favour of God was always there.

SOCIALLY

Christ was in favour with men. He had a social life; hence He could reach out to people of all sorts - rich or poor, sick or well, fat or slim, tall or short and such likes. There was no prejudice in Him.

PHYSICALLY

Stature – physique – Christ was in strength and health. He could move to places on foot before having His first vehicle or means of transport (The brand new donkey) and cruise boat, wherein he could sleep. He was strong in health and physique.

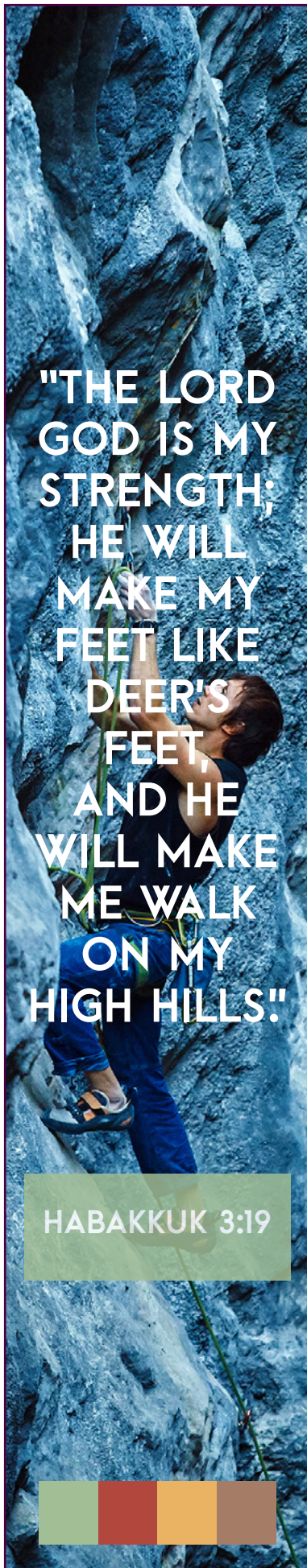
MENTALLY

Christ was a man of Wisdom. The desire for knowledge and understanding embodied and emboldened Him even at the age of twelve (12) with His parents in Jerusalem (Luke 2:40-52). He was able to handle and do life with all kinds of people even with the disgusting Pharisees, Sadducees, Philosophers, ill-mannered Lawyers, the poor and the rich, the sick, the homeless and tempters and such likes.

In light of Psalm 16:11, 3 John 2, Isaiah 40:28-31, Acts 24:16 and James 1:5, I strongly believe that God wants you to have a favourable relationship with Him as a path of defining your destiny in life. At the same time he wants to see you strengthen physically and in health and to do life in the manifold wisdom of His grace towards us, in light of what Jesus has done. He wants us to have tremendous grace in our day to day dealings with people. It's all yours in Him. You can begin today. Dare to triumph in four dimensions.

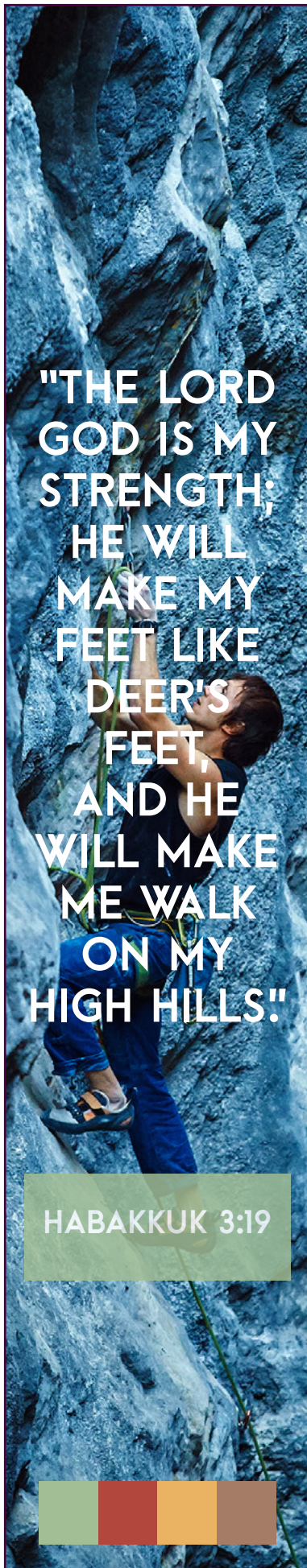

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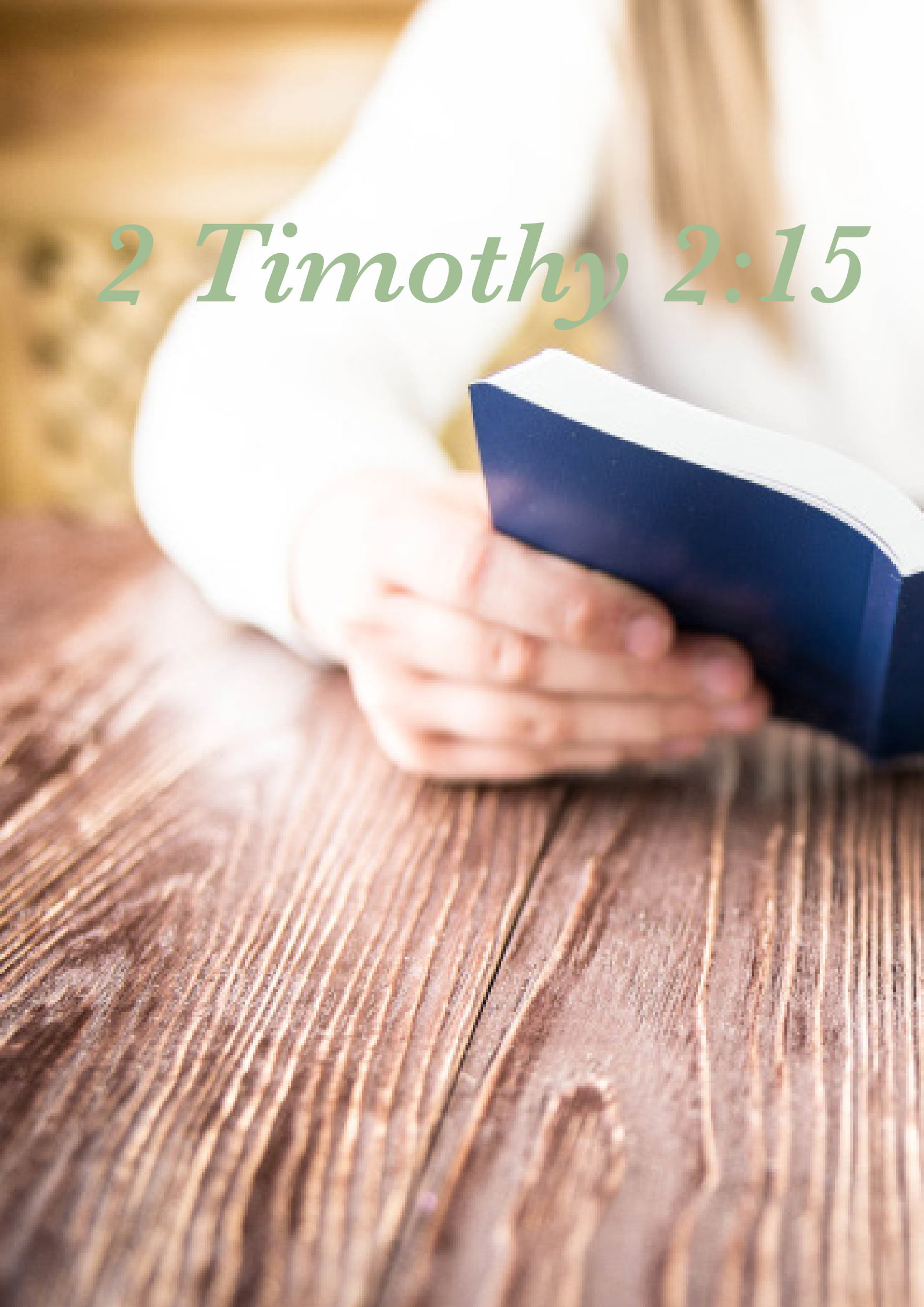


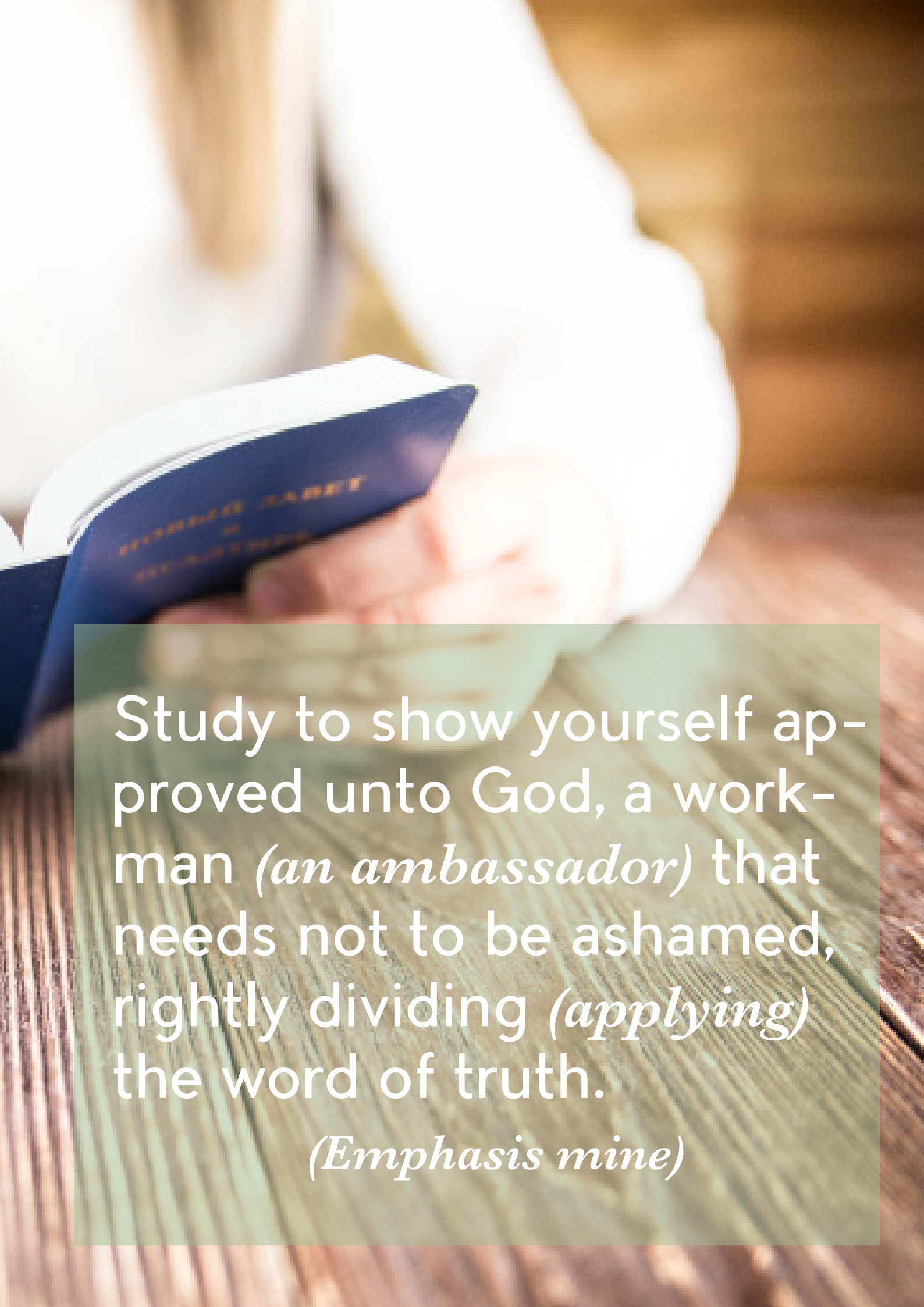

Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman *(an ambassador)* that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing *(applying)* the word of truth.

(Emphasis mine)

“The *blank* CHEQUE”

Picture this - your boss writes out a cheque for you with your bonus for the year. Before he hands it over to you, he takes an erasure and erases the signature and the amount and then hands it to you. Now what?! You cannot cash that cheque without the required credentials. The fact that he wrote it is not enough for the cheque to be legal tender. There is nothing there now.

Hebrews 11:1-3 . . . Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. 2 This is what the ancients were commended for. 3 By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

In the same way - when we make a confession that is in line with the Word of God - we are writing that cheque. As soon as we confess that the pain is still there - for example -; or that you still cannot afford your rent; that you are broke etc - we've erased the first confession. The cheque is now blank.

*Proverbs 6:2 ... You are snared by the words of your mouth;
You are taken by the words of your mouth.*

Examples are " I know I am healed, the Word of God says so." and yet still say, "The pain is still there but I know that it will go." That statement / confession has just nullified your healing. Words are spirit, they are life. Christianity has always been known as the great confession. Hold fast to your confession inspite of the situation you may be in because you know your rights according to the Word of God. The following scriptures speak for themselves on the importance of watching your mouth.

Hebrews 10:23... Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Proverbs 18:20-21 A man's stomach shall be satisfied from the fruit of his mouth; From the produce of his lips he shall be filled. 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

Romans 10:6-10 But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down from above) 7 or, "Who will descend into the abyss?" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). 8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Hebrews 3:14 For if we are faithful to the end, trusting God just as firmly as when we first believed, we will share in all that belongs to Christ.



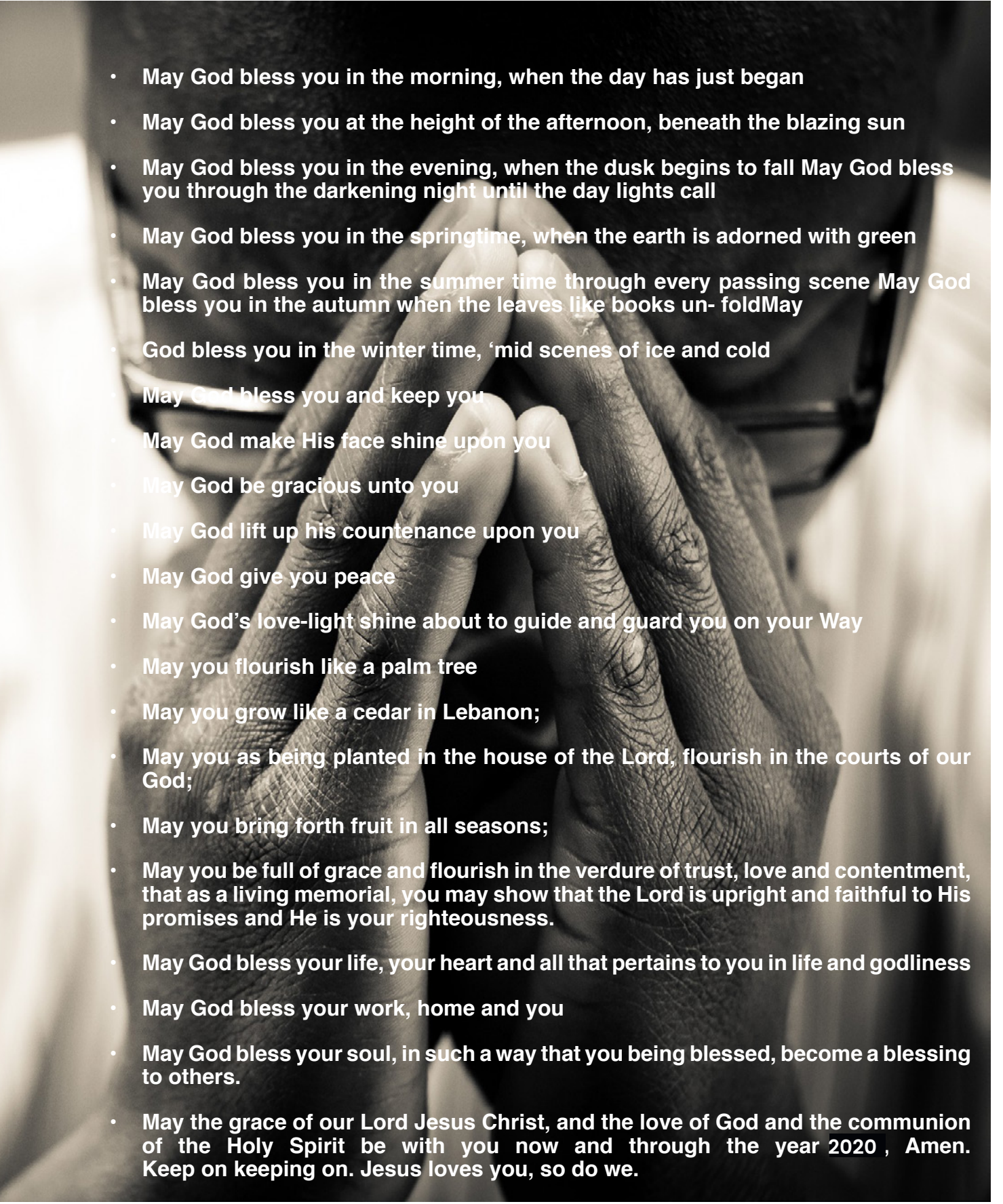
