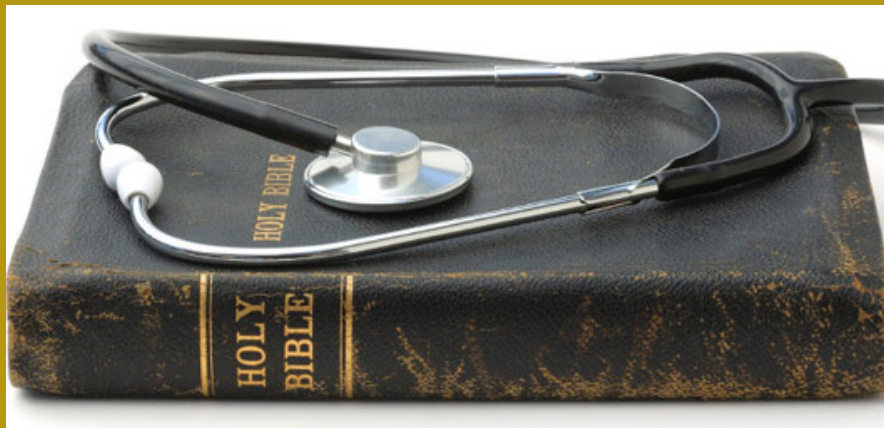

Philippians 1:21 “For to me, living means opportunities for Christ, and dying—well, that’s better yet!” (Living Bible)

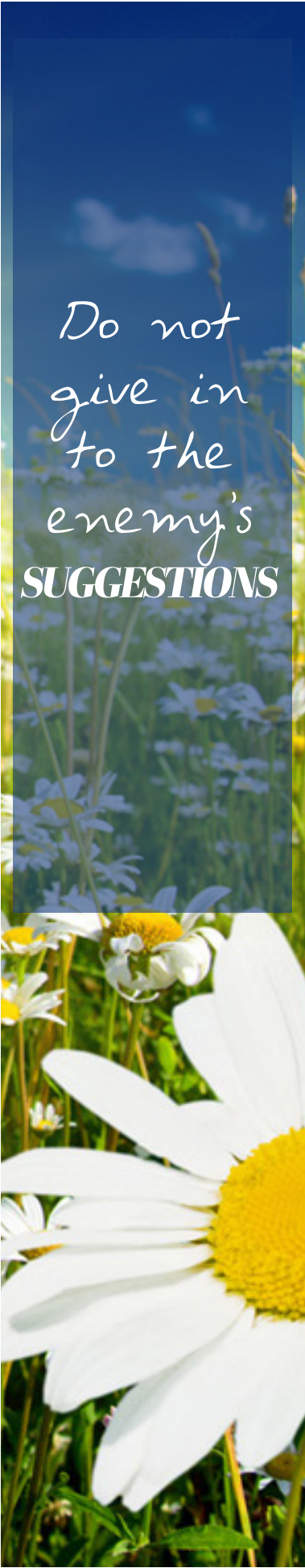

Psalms 65:11-13 "Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness. 12 They drop upon the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side. 13 The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing."

Ecclesiastes 7:8-10 "The end of a thing is better than its beginning; The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. 9 Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry, For anger rests in the bosom of fools. 10 Do not say, "Why were the former days better than these?" For you do not inquire wisely concerning this."

However far gone 2014 seem to be, you can still finish well. The scriptures say that the end of a thing is better than the beginning. As God promises, He always crowns the year with His goodness. Consider how you end 2014 to be the platform to begin the New Year with. Possibilities and opportunities are in the light of the Word of God for you; but do you believe? Can you believe? For us in CMI Ministries, RLIC Ministerial Church and AFD Teaching Publication, it's a year of DOMINION2015: "Living The Greater, Purposeful & Fulfilling Life." Dominion over Sin: Sickness, Poverty and Spiritual Death. That's in living the greater life that indwells in us with a set purpose and to actualise at the end, fulfilment. To prepare as a horse means to make ready with Plans, Purposes & Pursuits for God to see a reason to work with set goals.

DOMINION2015: PLAN, PURPOSE & PURSUIT!

Get rid of procrastination in your life - Now! There’s the need to be ‘prepared as the Horse’ before you take on the Year 2015. You don’t need to wait for the chance to make a success of your life.

The saying goes that when you don’t plan to succeed in life, you are equally planning to fail in life. Hence there’s this great need to make Plans with Purpose and with the intended act of Pursuit in order to succeed, triumph and become with God through His Word, Prayer and the Holy Spirit leadership.

The act to PREPARE - PLAN, PURPOSE & PURSUITS - is





more than just making a new year RESOLUTION. It's a strategic resolve and not a wishy-washy intent that disappears after few days, weeks or months. The outward manifestation of grace is the resolve of your secret dealings with the Lord as His ambassador.



No man goes to a strong man's house unprepared if there is an intention to possess or dispossess him and his cohorts. Meaning, that there's the need to prepare yourself with goals just as the horse is usually being prepared before the day of the battle or race.

Preparing as the horse before the battle means diligently setting out plans with purpose. Wisdom demands that you understand your time and opportunity in order to take on your life endeavours for the Year 2015, otherwise you may be cut suddenly with life challenges unprepared and you know that the fault lies with the failure to prepare.

DON'T TAKE THE ACT OF DOING LIFE FOR GRANTED, WHATEVER YOUR OCCUPATION BE PREPARED IF YOU MUST SUCCEED WITH GOD.

Proverbs 21:31 "The horse is prepared against the day of battle: but safety is of the Lord."

DOMINION2015 / JANUARY2015:

MAXIMIZE YOUR RESOURCE - TIME, EFFORT & FINANCE!

There's nothing greater than living for a cause. Life is meaningless without a sense of plan, purpose and pursuit. Begin each day for a cause; it's in there that you can maximize wisely, effectually and efficiently the God given major life resources - Time, Effort and Finance. You need to maximize them in order to enhance the quality of your personal life as a child of God and in the kingdom advancement.

The prudence and diligence that you give to your - time, effort and finance - does a lot to shape what you'll become as you do life in 2015. I say again these three resources - Time, Effort and Finance - will shape you; it will affect how you exercise dominion towards People, Material and Financial economy. You have to prepare for how to do life with them, because fluctuating in the usage of them, does not take you far:

- • You have 60seconds in a minute, 60minutes in an hour, 24hrs in a day, 7days in a week, 4weeks in a month or 52weeks in a year or 365days except for a leap year of 366days. Everyone has equal time and equal opportunity; The How and What you do with your time shapes your destiny no matter how





you transfer blame on someone else; Hence there's the need to ensure that your time count and account on things that advance, increase, multiply and add to your life and not on things that subtract, divide and limit you in year 2015. (Ecclesiastes 3:1; Ecclesiastes 8:5; Ecclesiastes 9:11-12; Ephesians 5:14-16 etc.)

- • You are given a basic strength of faith to meet your life challenges. God has dealt to every man THE measure, not A measure of faith. How and What you spend your energy of faith on shapes you. Diligence and prudence on your effort towards the cause of greatness will make you great. There's the need not to put your strength on the wishy-washy, foolish and slothful activities in order to enhance the quality of your life come year 2015. (Romans 12:3; Proverbs 22:29; 10:4; 27:23; 12:24; 13:4; Isaiah 52:13; Mark 12:33 etc.)
- • Just as you faithfully pay taxes to the government or for goods and services do not neglect paying your tithe and offering to God faithfully. Neglecting to save for or reinvest in matters of business and career means you are treading on dangerous ground too. There's a need to be faithful to your God's tithe, Caesar taxes, Business reinvestment and personal savings to enhance the quality of your life through year 2015. (Malachi 3:8-12; Matthew 23:23; Psalm 49:6-9; Proverbs 23:5; Matthew 22:17-20 etc.).

DOMINION 2015:

AND GOD BLESSED THEM - MALE & FEMALE!

Psalms 115:12-16 “*The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. 13 He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. 14 The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. 15 Ye are blessed of the Lord which made heaven and earth. 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord’s: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.”*

AFD YEAR 2015 EDITION

PREAMBLE: THE DAWN OF DOMINION2015

John 4:4 “*Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.”*

The term - Dominion - is defined below:

As a noun -

- • Sovereignty or control - “man’s attempt to



establish dominion over nature" - supremacy, ascendancy, dominance, domination, superiority, predominance, pre-eminence, primacy, hegemony, authority, mastery, control, command, direction, power, sway, rule, government, jurisdiction, sovereignty, suzerainty, lordship, overlordship .

- • As the territory of a sovereign or government - which means a - dependency, colony, protectorate, territory, province, outpost, satellite, domain, country, nation and land.



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The Hebrew word for dominion is translated 'radah'. This is also translated in other verses as "rule, reign, have, rule over, and prevail against. It means to have authority, rulership, reign and stewardship over things first and primarily and over satan and cohorts.

multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.”

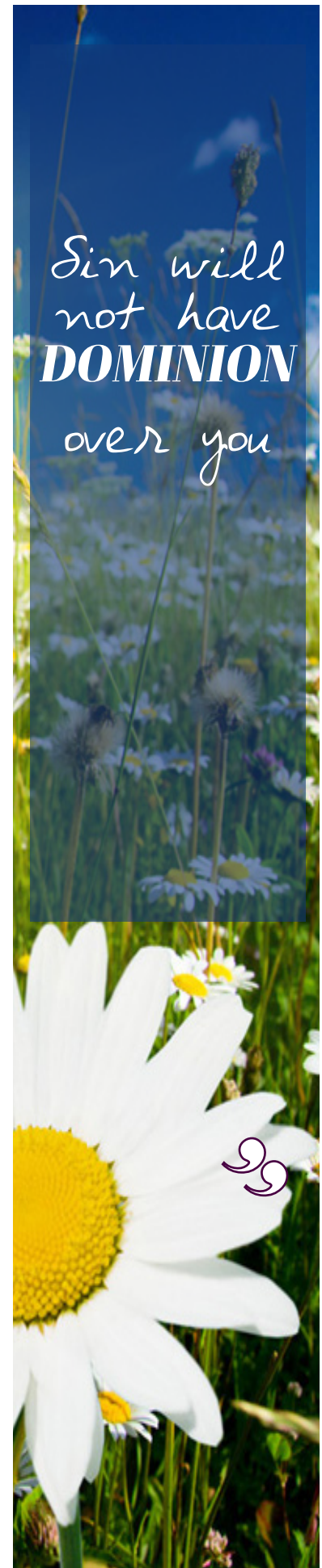
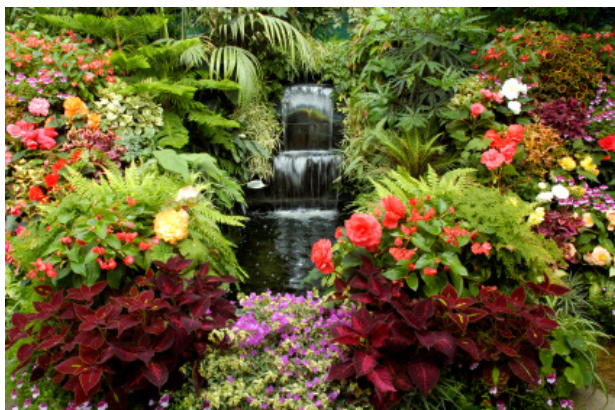
Matthew 16:19 *“I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind (declare to be improper and unlawful) on earth must be what is already bound in heaven; and whatever you loose (declare lawful) on earth must be what is already loosed in heaven.” (Amplified).*

To have Dominion means to have control of or over something. In Genesis 1:26-28 God gave man the power of attorney to oversee the earth in His mandate and assignment that man should “have dominion” over the earth. Meaning they were to act as God’s ambassadorial stewards in care for, guarding and controlling what happens on the earth. Also in Matthew 16:19 in re-enacting the spirit of dominion through the Church that whatsoever they allowed on earth, heaven would respect and whatsoever they disallowed the heavens would honour.

Romans 6:14 *“For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.”*

2 Corinthians 5:21 *“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.”*

Romans 6:14, assures us that by the virtue of what Christ did, Sin could not have dominion over us. Sin is the nature that brought about Poverty, Sickness and Spiritual Death. For we are now God’s hand of righteousness by the virtue of this





redemption accomplished through Christ as 2 Corinthians 5:21 indicates. Psalms 8:3-8 and Psalms 45:11-2 below, enforces the authenticity of the place of man in the purpose of creation by God. Man was made and place on earth to have dominion – be in charge and control - over the created works and acts of God. Amen!

Psalms 8:3-8 “When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; 4 what is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? 5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. 6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet: 7 all sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; 8 the fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas.”

Isaiah 45:11-12 “Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me. 12 I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded.”

I establish first and foremost that DOMINION as themed for the year 2015 is a done deed on our behalf by our Lord Jesus Christ. This is as ascertained in Ephesians 2:4-10, where we are highly lifted up, exalted and seated with Christ Jesus at the right hand of God our father by virtue of His REDEMPTION work on our behalf.

Ephesians 2:4-10 “But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: 7 that in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us

- • That knowledge is power, freedom and dominion, while religion is imprisonment and bondage - Luke 11:52.
- • That the grace that determines our status is a function of knowledge - 2 Peter 1:2.
- • That when you run after knowledge, goodness and mercy runs after you - Proverbs 1:22, 29-33.
- • That People who hate knowledge can't secure heaven's favour - Proverbs 13:15; Hosea 4:6; Isaiah 5:13-15.
- • That age is not equal to knowledge, and should not be taken for knowledge - Job. 32:7-9.
- • That if your thoughts are not updated, your life will be outdated - Proverbs 24:5.
- • That when you add a little MORE knowledge to your life daily, you live a little better - Proverbs 4:18.
- • That whatever you have no value for you have no access to - Mark. 6:5-6.
- • That studying for knowledge is not a transferable responsibility - 2 Timothy 2:15.
- • That the only authentic proof of knowledge is freedom and liberty - John 8:32.
- • That when you don't grow in the spirit of knowledge, you end up groaning in life - 2 Peter 3:18.

Proverbs 14:34 "Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people"

Romans 5:17, 21 "For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ . . . 21 that as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord."

2 Corinthians 5:17, 21 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him."

From Proverbs 14:34 we came to understand that exaltation of God is achievable through righteousness. Firstly, it's a done deed by the Father God to us in Christ Jesus our Lord and saviour in our REDEMPTION of Him. Righteousness is having a right standing with God. That is, the right and ability to stand before God without fear and shame, to approach Him with the understanding that He has made you righteous because of what Christ has done (Ephesians 2:4-10).

Seek the plans, purposes and pursuits of God and His righteousness then every other thing that we dare to pursue will be added unto us accordingly. (Matthew 6:25-34 and Luke 12:22-33).



The Sin nature has been dealt with on the cross for our redemption in order for us to live and reign in dominion. Hence sin should not have dominion over us. Romans 6:14 enjoins us not allow it to, in order for us to effect the working power of righteousness that is at work in us. If we can't put down the flesh under, there will be trouble in our ability to live in dominion as 1 Corinthians 9:27 indicate.

Acts 10:34-35 “Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: 35 but in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.”

To emphasise the importance of righteousness with God for us, Acts 10:34-35 indicates that people's limitations in life are not because of where they come from, which family they were born in or the colour of their skin or whatever entitlement one wishes to give as an excuse. According to the scriptures, God is not a respecter of

person's and there is no controversy where His kingdom plans, purposes and pursuits are concerned; more so, in every nation, whosoever works righteousness, God accepts and gives the grace to function and become in life in His kingdom.

God made the poor and the rich people, but did not make one poor nor another rich but each by their choices in life function and become what they became (1 Samuel 2:7-10; Genesis 26:1-5, 12-14).

What we become is born in the secret of our daily routine and activities in life. Isaiah 59:1-2 "Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: 2 but your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."

Isaiah 32:17 "And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever."

As those who have received the gift of righteousness bestowed on us because of Christ, we can only function, become and reign in life by living the life of righteousness without compromise. There is no apology for that or any room to belittle what God abhors to satisfy our fleshy desire. This is what it is all about in Romans 5:17, 21. The scriptures speaking concerning Christ Jesus in Psalms 45:6-7 and in parallel with Hebrews 1:8-9 indicate that He was anointed and exalted above His fellows while in humanity because He loved righteousness and hated sin or iniquities and unrighteous ways. He understood God's kingdom plans, purposes and pursuits of doing life; and if He is the way, the truth and the life (John 14:6) as we believe of Him, then let's walk in His ways to the Father God and experience the graces of EXALTATION in this Dominion 2015 and until the Lord returns.

Psalms 45:6-7 "Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. 7 Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows."

Hebrews 1:8-9 "But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom. 9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows."

He equally subdued all things and reigned over all limitations of the flesh. The scriptures declare that, as He is, so we are and ought to be in this world. • • **OVER THE FLESH**

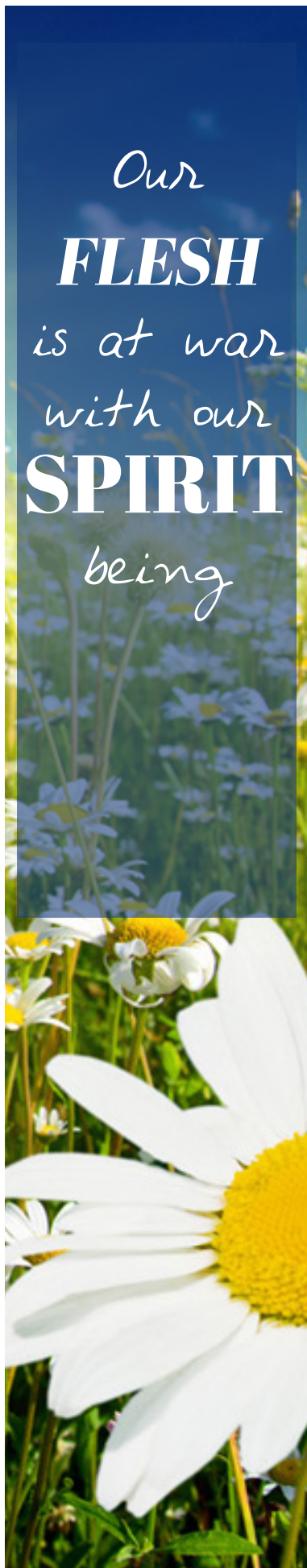

James 4:1-10 “From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? 2 Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. 3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. 4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. 5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? 6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. 7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. 8 Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. 9 Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. 10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.”

1 Peter 5:5-11 “Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resists the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. 6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: 7 casting all your care upon him; for he cares for you. 8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour: 9 whom resist steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world. 10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect,

establish, strengthen, settle you. 11 To him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.”

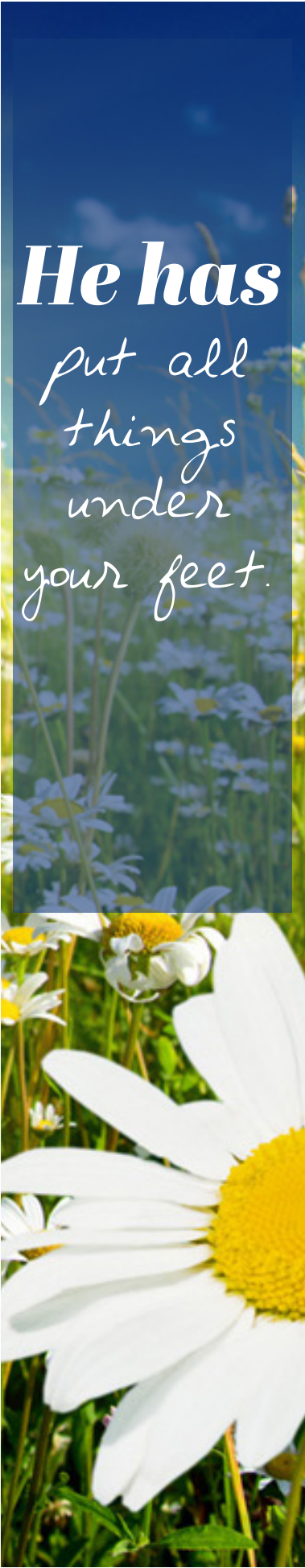
May I begin this section by saying that our attitude will always bring about our altitude in life.

Have you sometimes wondered why some prayers are never answered? It is not because God does not hear prayers or does not want to answer prayers (Psalms 65:1-2), but the unwillingness to humble ourselves before God and His word of righteousness have in most cases deluded us from actualising and receiving from God and from being a vessel of change. This is what James 4:1-10 is about. Our God will only commend what He commands. And the act of dominion depends on it.

We can't live outside being humble to God and His words of righteousness at all levels and then want to get to the top overnight. Galatians 5:16-18 indicates that our fleshy being is at war with our spirit being and our spirit being is God's sensor to our triune-being (Proverbs 20:27; Job 32:8; 33:4); Since our fleshy being is always unwilling to submit to the authority of God's word, yet wants to enjoy the position of dominion in the kingdom, there comes a war between our fleshy desire and spirit-being desire towards God's plans, purposes and pursuits for our life - James 4:1-3. We see that fleshy-spirit of rebellion in our places of worship, homes, marriages and place of work and in every place of human endeavours.

It's for this that James 4:6-10 and 1 Peter 5:5-7, indicates that God will always bring down the proud no matter their position of height and will always exalt the humble to a place of dominion no matter how low they had been. You might have read how God humble spouses or marriages (Acts 5:1-11) who want to take God's word for a ride; and also, people in places of honour being brought down for taking and using their position of trust and grace to oppress others - Luke 12:15-21. It is in the law of life and much more the encoded spiritual law of God. The way out of this is the words of exhortation in Romans 12:1-2 and Ephesians 4:20-24, which is about not conforming but being transformed by the renewing of our minds, that is, being renewed in the spirit of our mind.

Romans 12:1-2 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God." Philipians 2:5-11 "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: 6 who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: 7 but made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: 8 and being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. 9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

Ephesians 4:20-24 "But ye have not so learned Christ; 21 if so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: 22 that ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind; 24 and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness."

It is of this knowledge and understanding of humility that our Lord Jesus in humanity takes after the writings of Philipians 2:5-11. Hence the scriptures said, let this mind be in you which was also in Christ. The mind set of being humble. It is the kingdom way for exaltation through dominion for all saints. It is this that made our Lord Jesus to be highly exalted above all things, in the heavens, on earth and beneath the earth. Humility is not being stupid, foolish or ignorant, but an act that says, let God and His word of righteousness prevail over me in

all situations even when it is not comfortable or generally unacceptable.

Do you really want to be honoured, that is, exalted in the kingdom way and operate with the spirit of dominion? I mean the honour and exaltation of God that no man can bring down no matter how they try to? The realm of grace to live the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life is imbedded in the spirit of humility. Take a look after Christ and see life through the mirror of the scriptures of James 1:22-25 and also in these wisdom bank scriptures below.

Proverbs 15:33 *“The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is humility.”*

Proverbs 18:12 *“Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, and before honour is humility.”*

Proverbs 22:4 *“By humility and the fear of the Lord are riches, and honour, and life.”*

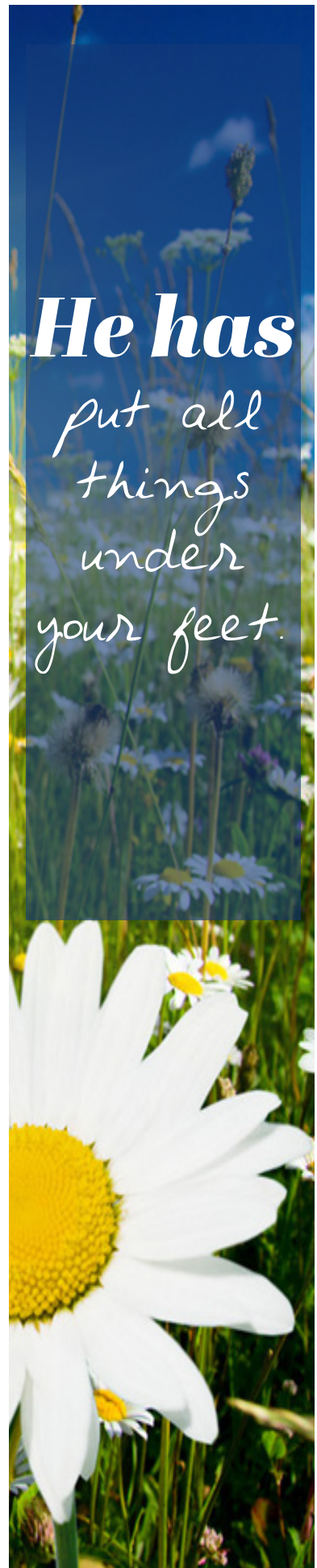

And he answered, The way through the wilderness of Edom. 9 So the king of Israel went, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there was no water for the host, and for the cattle that followed them. 10 And the king of Israel said, Alas! that the LORD hath called these three kings together, to deliver them into the hand of Moab! 11 But Jehoshaphat said, Is there not here a prophet of the LORD, that we may enquire of the LORD by him? And one of the king of Israel's servants answered and said, Here is Elisha the son of Shaphat, which poured water on the hands of Elijah. 12 And Jehoshaphat said, The word of the LORD is with him. So the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat and the king of Edom went down to him. 13 And Elisha said unto the king of Israel, What have I to do with thee? get thee to the prophets of thy father, and to the prophets of thy mother. And the king of Israel said unto him, Nay: for the LORD hath called these three kings together, to deliver them into the hand of Moab. 14 And Elisha said, As the LORD of hosts liveth, before whom I stand, surely, were it not that I regard the presence of Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, I would not look toward thee, nor see thee. 15 But now bring me a minstrel. And it came to pass, when the minstrel played, that the hand of the LORD came upon him. 16 And he said, Thus saith the LORD, Make this valley full of ditches. 17 For thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley shall be filled with water, that ye may drink, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts. 18 And this is but a light thing in the sight of the LORD: he will deliver the Moabites also into your

hand. 19 And ye shall smite every fenced city, and every choice city, and shall fell every good tree, and stop all wells of water, and mar every good piece of land with stones. 20 And it came to pass in the morning, when the meat offering was offered, that, behold, there came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.”

Psalms 107:35 “*He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings.*”

Isaiah 35:6-7 “*Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert. 7 And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water: in the habitation of dragons, where each lay, shall be grass with reeds and rushes.*”

Isaiah 41:17-20 “*When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them. 18 I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water. 19 I will plant in the wilderness the cedar, the shittah tree, and the myrtle, and the oil tree; I will set in the desert the fir tree, and the pine, and the box tree together: 20 That they may see, and know, and consider, and understand together, that the hand of the LORD hath done this, and the Holy One of Israel hath created it”*

Zachariah 10:1 “*Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.*”

Psalms 65:11 makes it very clear that God is determined to crown your life through the year with His goodness. Instead of leanness, fatness will He drop with the goodness. It will be great if you can take time and read the entire Psalms 65 chapter. What an exalted, opportune, possibility and surprise position to maximize with God in all your life dealings through the year. Psalms 8 indicates

how much God is mindful of man and as such has given him dominion over things - over all the works of His hands. This indicates how much He wants man to be in the place of being His ambassador on earth as it was at creation - The place of DOMINION. You can also sense the state of God's mindfulness towards man's well-being in His determination to have him bless and take on his place of dominion on earth along with his children as *Psalms 115: 9-16* says.

“O Israel, trust thou in the Lord: he is their help and their shield. 10 O house of Aaron, trust in the Lord: he is their help and their shield. 11 Ye that fear the Lord, trust in the Lord: he is their help and their shield. 12 The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. 13 He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. 14 The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. 15 Ye are blessed of the Lord which made heaven and earth. 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.”

Every day each one of us intending achieve substantially in Christ is engaged with battles of life in various ways and for various reasons which the scriptures call the fight of faith and spiritual warfare - 1 Timothy 6:12; 1 Timothy 1:18; 2 Corinthians 10:3-6.

It's great to know that the Lord wants to assist you in winning your wars as an achiever in unusual ways as it happens in 2 Kings 3:4-20. God wants to flood your life in a special way that you have never experienced Him before. God wants you to live in the realm of the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life of dominion.

In 2 Kings 3:4-20, three kings - king of Israel, Judah and Edom - were engaged in war with the people of Moab. On their way to the battle they encountered a problem - NO Water To Drink. Meaning two problems to deal with; first is winning the battle and the second is having the resources to accomplish it.

In Verse 10 of 2 Kings 3:4-20, the king of Israel started nursing defeat even before the battle, just as most

people will do today; just before they take a step of faith in any life challenges, defeat is already concluded in their minds. The king thought that in order for them to win as a form of assurance, God would have provided everything first. But the believer in Christ intending to experience kingdom exaltation in the realm of dominion should know that we walk by faith and not by sight as the scriptures say in 2 Corinthians 5:7 "For we walk by faith, not by sight". Our Life victory can only come by our faith belief which is accompanied by the principle of our confession and declaration on the integrity of God's Word in our life. Scriptural Readings - Mark 11:20-24; Hebrews 10:23, 35; Romans 10:6-13.

But King Jehoshaphat of Judah in Verse 11 had a different view in that he asked and requested for the man of God that would receive from God and speak into the situation. That's why you must belong to a Church where your pastor can speak into your life the mystery of God's will; which will also unveil all the concealed matters of God's grace that concern you. I challenge you today, look for a living church and submit to spiritual leadership and don't be like a spiritual harlot - (Hosea 12:13; Deuteronomy 29:29 and 2 Chronicles 20:20b). And the Word of the Lord came eventually from God's servant *Elisha in verse 17:*

"For thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley shall be filled with water, that ye may drink, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts."





You shall not see wind or rain but the VALLEY will be wet and filled with water that is UNUSUAL. THAT VALLEY in your life that you have battled with in 2014 and in years before, God wants to fill it with WATER so that you can cruise and do life with dignity and not in shame.

This is the unusual goodness of God for you in DOMINION2015. Verse 18 further says that winning the battle is a light thing in the sight of the Lord, in that He will deliver the Moabites into their hands. What powerful and authentic words of grace to hear and receive into any life in a tumbling situation, especially when access to hope seems gone in human concept. This is what I call the double-dose, asking for one and gathering double blessings. The King did not ask Elisha to find out about winning the battle, yet God gave them a double-dose of blessings - The DRINK to energize them and the VICTORY and TRIUMPH so much desired.

Vs. 18: "And this is but a light thing in the sight of the LORD: he will deliver the Moabites also into your hand."

"I speak forth and declare unto you that in year 2015, for every one request, may God give you double blessings. May He go beyond your expectation in the precious name of our Lord Jesus, Amen! May our God turn your wilderness into standing water and your dry ground into water springs as in Psalm 107:35.

May our God satisfy and fulfil your limitations as promised in Isaiah 35:6-7 and Isaiah 41:17-20. May you find rain to blossom as in Zachariah 10:1; May all of these bring you to the place where you are exalted in dominion and with unusual goodness; and being fulfilled in your life in 2015 and thereafter in Jesus name, amen! I challenge you today to GO forth, drink, win and triumph to celebrate your God in the land of the living, amen and amen." IT'S YOUR YEAR OF DOMINION!

DOMINION2015:

DOMINION ENHANCES TRIUMPH!

Romans 8:35-39 "Who shall separate us from

the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

2 Corinthian 2:14 “Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.”

1 Corinthians 15:57-58 “But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.”

Romans 8: 35-38 sums up the event of the year ending 2014 to some extent in many of our lives. When you section the scriptures by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, you will discover that all aspects of life and their results in terms of - physical, social, emotional, spiritual, mental, financial, security, natural disasters and such likes are all summed up in that verse. This is true for individuals, for families or nations and governments.

These challenges in Romans 8:35-39 have caused many to give up their faith in God and to have a tendency to either believe the mere fact of life rather than the truth that the scripture offers. A close look at the scripture in context indicates that it's not questioning about Christ loving us madly and ravishing His glory upon us but the question is directed towards and about us loving Christ. It is a call for us to be able to see life through the mirror of what Christ's love has made us become. We can then be able to turn tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, peril, wars and such likes inside out, to a place of success and exaltation in dominion. Success or exaltation in dominion





is about turning circumstances, calamities and failures inside out.

When you walk into year 2015 with the concept that God has made you a VICTOR and MORE THAN A CONQUEROR through Christ, you will not let what will come your way as it happened in year 2014 determine your destiny and your daily joy. Because God has said you are a victor and not a victim, you are more than a conqueror and you are made to triumph not just in one place or situation but in every single place or situation that comes your way - 2 Corinthians 2:14; 1 Corinthians 15:57 and Romans 8:37.

Success is what I call failure turned inside out. You are the one who determines the atmosphere you want to enjoy. The colour and sphere of life you want to found around you. By this I mean that you are a thermostat not a thermometer. A thermostat detects the temperature of the environment while a thermometer absorbs or receives the temperature of the surroundings. God is in the know to exalt you, that is, to perfect and complete all that concerns you. To ensure you live in the realms of dominion indicating what you want to happen in your life and not circumstances deciding for you.

Philippians 1:6 “Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:”

1 Peter 5:10 “But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, establish, strengthen, settle you.”

2015 being a year of dominion is an exaltation of grace, full of opportunities, possibilities and surprises for God’s people. You need to brace up your faith, get set to ride on the great opportunities and possibilities the Lord will bring your way for your exaltation. This is the year to see through the mirror of who God has made you to become no matter the challenges - Genesis 26:1-5, 12-14. I pray that you will know how much love Christ has lavished on you, that nothing will limit you. You are more than conquerors through Him that loves you, amen.

DOMINION2015:

DOMINION THROUGH INCLINING TO GOD'S SAYINGS

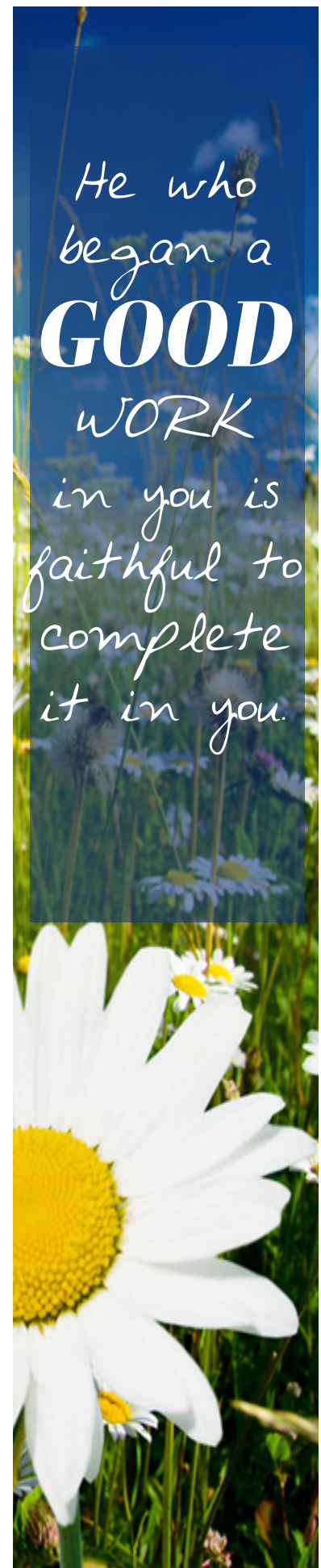
Proverbs 4:18-22 “But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day. The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble. My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health (medicine) to all their flesh”. (Emphasis mine)

Isaiah 55:8-9 “For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts”.

Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end”.

Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.” (Amplified)

In this ministerial outfit of AFD, we've made a covenant with God that year 2015 will be filled with great possibilities, opportunities and majestic surprises as we live the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life; It's our intention also, that God's people in Christ Jesus will experience with us, in spite of what news they hear, see and feel. From Isaiah 55:8-9 and Jeremiah 29:11 we get one prominent statement of faith as to us living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life - that our God is faithful, consistently consistent in His thoughts and plan, purpose and pursuit about us. He is a God who will keep to commend His command and His sayings, even in the midst of our life's mess-ups; and if only we will incline our ears and attend to His sayings as indicated in Proverbs 4:18-22 and keep them in the frontlets of our eyes as we are being exhorted in **Deuteronomy 6:6-12** below.





“And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: 7 and thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. 8 And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. 9 And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates. 10 And it shall be, when the Lord thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he swore unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not, 11 and houses full of all good things, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full; 12 then beware lest thou forget the Lord, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.”

I prayerfully urge and compel you to own a diary or notebook to write down every single instruction God will minister to you time and again in the course of His leading; this is the pathway of you accomplishing His plans, purposes and pursuits for your life to exaltation. When you obey the word of the Lord, the word will shape your daily joy and destiny. Give your ears to the voice of the Holy Spirit speaking into your spirit being to shape and mould your destiny and your life on a daily basis. The words will colour your life and create the atmosphere you really want to have and enjoy.

Proverbs 4:18-22 *“But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day. The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble. My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health (medicine) to all their flesh”.* (Emphasis mine)

Attending and inclining to the Lord's saying will beam

His grace upon you to do life and live godly. Just as the moon has no light in itself but receives the beam from the sun rays as it inclines itself to the sun for a full beam reflection of light; in the same scenario when we incline to the Lord's sayings, which is His Word, we will radiate the glory of grace to win in life and triumph daily in our endeavours.

1 John 5:7 *“For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.”*

John 1:1-5, 14 *“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not . . . And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth”*

You would have known that when the moon moves away from the beam of the sun, it becomes a half eclipse or total eclipse since there is no much more or any of the sun beams of light to reflect. It was in this same act, that the sun of righteousness that Apostle Paul saw at midday did turn His life and ministry around according to the holy writ record of Malachi 4:2 and Acts 26:13-19. The beam of that light was not the mere SUN but the SON of God, Lord Jesus, who spoke to him then and then of His plan, purpose and pursuit for his life. No wonder Apostle Paul was such an extraordinary man. We need such inclination to transform, translate and transfigure our life and ministry (life assignment which could be education, career, business, family, relationship and such like) if we must experience a life lasting dominion in Christ Jesus.

Malachi 4:2 *“But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.”*

Acts 26:13-19 *“At midday, O king, I saw in the way*





a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me. 14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. 15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest. 16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen,

and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee; 17 delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee, 18 to open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.”

It is on the basis of inclination that Jeremiah 29:11 and Isaiah 55:8-9 become meaningful. Therein is God's eternal good thought for our welfare, peace and fulfilment:

- God's thoughts and plans toward us are good & not evil.
- God's plans for us are peaceful.
- God plans are full of hope and a beautiful future for us
- God has a great purpose for our welfare
- God's pursuit is to see us get to our final outcome in life fulfilled.
- .. & much more such like.

Inclining to the sayings of God is what will take you to your promised blessings in DOMINION2015. This is a choice that you have to make lest you walk like mere men and not as God's chosen child designed for victory and triumph.

DOMINION2015:

DOMINION BY EXERCISING THE FORCE OF FAITH

Matthew 11:11-12 “Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.”

1 Timothy 4:8 “For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.”

2 Timothy 1:6 “For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”

2 Timothy 1:6-7 “For God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.” (Amplified).

Beloved, the essence and total package of dominion to advance the kingdom of our God and to keep the enemy at bay as it affects our redemption is not for the cowardly, the fearful, the timid and those who are craven; and not for those who don't want to arise and take their place in REDEMPTION recreation. The scriptures in context indicate that only by way of exercise, that is, an act to make steady effort, demonstrate and put into action, can we have profitable blessings in all things not only in this life but in the life to come. That is to say that if you don't take your place, the enemy can even send you home before time. The promise to complete package in year 2015 is in exercising your force (entrusted power of attorney) of Faith. Faith is not a doctrine or creed to be merely preached but a lifestyle that we must live out on a daily basis to be justified unto dominion.

Hebrews 11:3, 6 “Through faith we understand





that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. 6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him”.

Habakkuk 2:4 *“Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.” (Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38)*

Romans 14:23 *“And he that doubteth is damned if he eat, because he eateth not of faith: for whatsoever is not of faith is sin.”*

Hebrews 11:3, 6 and Habakkuk 2:4 and Romans 14:23 indicate the need for spiritual exercise of faith - 1 Timothy 4:8. The exercise that creates and brings about our dominion that leads us to profit, which is called the force of faith as enjoined in John 12:11-12. Until the days of John the Baptist, men who had enjoyed profitable exalted and dominion in living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling kingdom life were people who refused to compromise and to give up or give in to mere chance because of opposition and challenges before them. The kingdom call today, is a call for all believing and intending Achievers' of God, who want to make a meaningful and colourful life for themselves and others, to arise in their spirit with the force of faith, in order to live the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life. That is, acting on the basis of the word to every situation to win in life and grace.

Romans 10:17 *“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”*

1 John 5:4 *“For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.”*

On this account of the need to triumph in life, I make bold to say that: “Only the violent in faith, I mean born of the word of faith (Romans 10:17, 1 John 5:4 and Hebrews 11:3) that it's operating in the realm of the Spirit, will be able to dispossess the enemy; and break forth into the fullness of all things that Christ has made available for them to enhance living the greater, purposeful and

fulfilling life in dominion. Otherwise we live within the concept of religious activities and suffer as those without God and without hope in this world”.

Are you called or have strong leading to be in business, politics, education, medicine, science, technology, social, government, spiritual leadership, an entrepreneur and such likes? They don't come by chance, if they did, you would not last in the field. Such colourful life is not sustained in its fulness by being a mere Christian of chance, who is complacent of their faith not being put to work until chance comes. If we must become a voice (Luke 3:4) and not a mere echo in this dispensation and generation, we must arise with the Spirit of grace that is under the influence of the force of faith to bring the changes that posterity will reckon with and celebrate. The kingdom will populate and the enemy will be kept at bay. Year 2015 is not for cowards nor the fearful, therefore arise boldly in the light of the scriptures to make a profitable and colourful year 2015 in your God given place of dominion as ***Psalms 8:3-8*** says.

“When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; 4 what is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? 5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. 6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet: 7 all sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; 8 the fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever passeth through the paths of the seas.”

DOMINION2015:

DOMINION BY TILLING YOU LAND WITH DILIGENCE

Ecclesiastes 9:10-13 “Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work,





nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest. I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all. 12For man also knoweth not his time: as the fishes that are taken in an evil net, and as the birds that are caught in the snare; so are the sons of men snared in an evil time, when it falleth suddenly upon the. This wisdom have I seen also under the sun, and it seemed great unto me”.

Ecclesiastes 9:10-13 indicates to us that the race to greatness is available to all men on equal terms and with equal time and opportunities. What individuals do with the time and opportunities available to them will determine which phase and size of life they will live on; whether the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life or the wishy-washy, causeless, clueless and failing life.

Nobody has more than 12 Months, 52 Weeks, 365 Days, 8760 Hours, 525600 Minutes and 31536000 Seconds per year; and the life of dominion as an achiever per months, weeks, days, hours, minutes and seconds is not always in the same results for all despite equal terms of the chance (time) and opportunities that are available to



all.

You can choose to be idle and waste all the opportunities available for you within a God given time frame or maximize it for your greatness in your ability to equate your given time to your life endeavours.

Over the years I have come to know as I meditate on the word of the Lord why many great prophecies given to people as individuals or groups remained stalled or appear to be unfulfilled. It is because some people either by ignorance or lack of sufficient knowledge and understanding of the terms involved. They just receive the prophetic declaration at the beginning of the year with great excitement accompanied by fasting without walking diligently in the fulfilment of the words of grace spoken to their life accordingly.

Proverbs 22:28-29 “Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers have set. Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men”.

There is an ancient landmark in the scripture (Proverbs 22:28-29) that makes the diligent stand before kings (people and places of honour, greatness, purpose and fulfilment) and not with the mere, obscure and mean men (complainers and murmurers and such likes); and also that makes God reward those who diligently seek Him. It is the spirit of diligence that makes some stand out from others even though they all have equal opportunities and time to be successful in life and to be placed in an exalted position of DOMINION.

In 2015, colourful living is not for those who are lazy, slothful and the sluggard; and their inability to walk in God's prophetic statement of faith. Crown success is not for the idle minded but for the diligent living in the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life realm. Diligence - a consistent steady effort to achieve - is for those who want to do life and reign in life and be crowned as kings in their doings even as the scripture promises.

Revelation 5:9-10 “And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth”.

Romans 5:17 “For if by one man's offence death

reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)”.

1 Peter 2:5, 9 “ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ . . . 9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.”

Being a redeemed child of God demands for the pressing in order for us to make progress, and reign in life always and even in 2015; It’s not enough to know only that you have been redeemed and made kings and are a royal priesthood and to reign in life in the realm of dominion as enjoined in Revelation 5:9-10 and Romans 5:17 and 1 Peter 2:5, 9. We need to know also that great and established achievement is recorded on diligent plans, purposes and pursuits. He that diligently tills his ground shall have plenty of bread (success, achievement and fulfilment) say the scriptures of Proverbs 12:11 and Proverbs 28:19.

Proverbs 12:11 “He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain persons is void of understanding”.

Proverbs 28:19 “He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain persons shall have poverty enough”.

Diligence involves investing your abilities, strength, time, finance and all that you have into the goal pursuit of your life vision and mission for year 2015; this enables, orders and earns you the desired colourful crown year of living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life. Not engaging in diligence but in sluggard acts and slothfulness will not only rob one of dominion but leads to potential limitations, poverty, lack and being beggarly in life.

Proverbs 6:6-11 “Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: 7 which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, 8 provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the

harvest. 9 How long wilt thou sleep, O sluggard? when wilt thou arise out of thy sleep? 10 Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: 11 so shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man."

Proverbs 10:4-5 *"He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich. 5 He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame."*

Proverbs 13:4 *"The soul of the sluggard desireth, and hath nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat."*

Proverbs 20:4 *"The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; therefore shall he beg in harvest, and have nothing."*

Proverbs 24:30-34 *"I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding; 31 and, lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down. 32 Then I saw, and considered it well: I looked upon it, and received instruction. 33 Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: 34 so shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man."*

God will only prosper the committed assignment in your life by prospering your efforts, your investments and time toward your goals through diligent endeavours no matter how long it takes if you remain faithful to the core - **Hebrews 11:3**.

"Therefore I warn and say to you if you must reign and live the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life to:

"Run away from idleness and idle people who have made themselves sluggard, because idleness is a career for some and it's a carrier of POVERTY which could be spiritual, physical, and financial and such likes, and which can only be remedy through diligence. Idleness is

a cancerous disease, so fly away from it. It makes the acts of redemption of no effect in the life of those that live in it and corrupts those who make friendship to those that love it".

Therefore invest in labour - diligently tilling your land - and reap the great exalted harvest of year 2015. For your part in year 2015 is the task of planting and watering, God's task is to bring about the increase and overflow in unusual way if it comes to that - 1 Corinthians 3:6-7; Philippians 3:14; 1 Corinthians 9:24; Psalm 1:1-3.

Be diligent in prayers, in studying the scriptures, in fellowship and ministry, in business and in all aspects of doing life to enable you know how to observe and receive the God's given inspiration, revelation and empowerment for your breakthroughs and breaking-forth in living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life.

Joshua 1:8 "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."

Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching"

DOMINION THROUGH OBEDIENCE & JOYFUL SERVICE

Job 36:11 "If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasure"

Ex 23:25-27 "And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I

will fulfil. I will send my fear before thee, and will destroy all the people to whom thou shalt come, and I will make all thine enemies turn their backs unto thee”.

Deuteronomy 28:47-48 *“Because thou servedst not the Lord thy God with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things; 48 therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the Lord shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all things: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee.”*

Isaiah 1:19 *“If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land”*

Joshua 24:14-18 *“Now therefore fear the Lord, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the Lord. 15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. 16 And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the Lord, to serve other gods; 17 for the Lord our God, he it is that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and which did those great signs in our sight, and preserved us in all the way wherein we went, and among all the people through whom we passed: 18 and the Lord drove out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: therefore will we also serve the Lord; for he is our God.”*

The condition of the world today, in the areas of the economy, political instabilities and uncertainties, climatic and weather unpredictability, natural disasters in floods and earthquakes is becoming very challenging; much so are terrorists and terrorism invasions, cyber dynamics, technological innovations and other acts of life that are far





beyond the thought that it's the fault of any individual, group of people and nation that may have been attributed with the evils and problems in the past – be it domestic, national or otherwise.

To live in the realm of the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life of dominion, one must resolved to serve the Lord God joyfully, willingly and obediently. In a way these happenings and challenges in the world today are a process through which God wants His Church, that is, you the achiever in Christ, to arise and take your stage; and use your position of joyful and willing SERVICE in the kingdom through OBEDIENCE to bring about God's plans, purposes and pursuits to the world in His Church.

Man's wisdom and acts of cunningness and craftiness will definitely be turned to foolishness by the unparalleled God given wisdom to His Church. He wants His Church to use His given wisdom of dominion to dispose of the strongholds of darkness and to teach the world and satanic cohorts the path of righteousness, the true riches and prosperity that comes from the uncreated creator God.

Ephesians 3:10-11 "To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:"

Job 5:12 "He disappointeth the devices of the crafty, so that their hands cannot perform their enterprise."

Contextually the scriptures on obedience in Job 36:11, Exodus 23:25-27, Isaiah 1:19 and Joshua 24:14-18 indicate that if we obey and serve Him, the followings will accompany us in living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life of dominion:

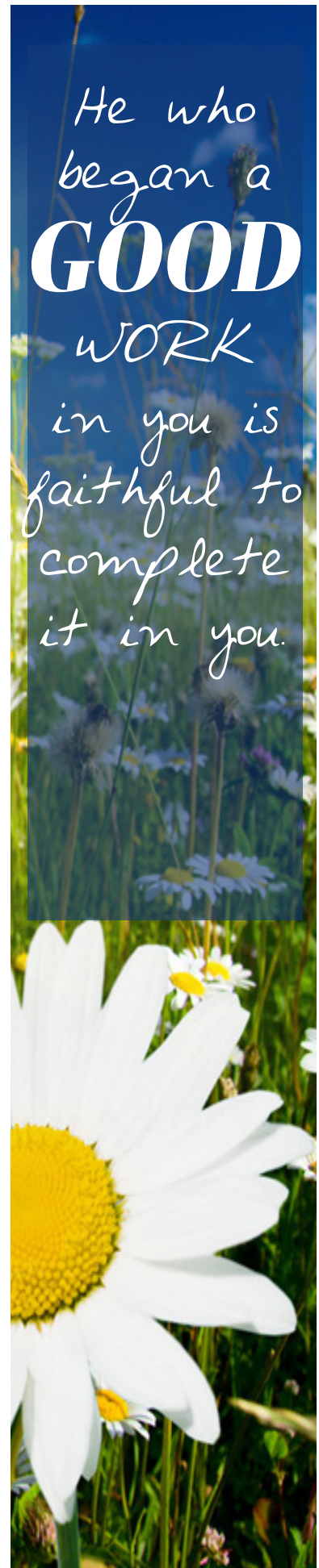
- We will spend our days in prosperity.

- We will be in good health and strength.

- We will not have miscarriages in body, vision, ministry, marriages, business etc.
- We will be free from the evil that is in the world
- .. And many more such like. (See 2 Peter 1:1-13; John 15:1-8).

These are the days when our Christian faith is being challenged by what is happening in our world on a daily basis and the falsehood that has slipped into the church through negligence. It is only by engaging in serving the Lord through absolute obedience that we can bring about a true and lasting change in our lives and through our lives to the community and society at large in such a time as this. Serving the Lord and in obedience includes - but not limited to - the following:

- Investing in our time and opportunities
- Investing financially in all way of doing life
- Investing in life sacrificially in all social services
- Investing in our physical and mental abilities.
- Investing in our spiritual and ministerial abilities
- Engaging in various opportunities in the Services of a local church.
- Reaching out to the poor and needy.
- Giving towards missionary causes
- Reaching out to the causes of your community and neighbourhood
- .. And many more and such like.

Serving the Lord in obedience can only be achieved through the heart of love in spirit and in truth. We cannot serve the Lord effectively without genuine love in our hearts and lives. In 1 Corinthians 12, we are told of spiritual gifts but to effectively function and manifest in and with them as exemplified in 1 Corinthians 14, there is an injunction in chapter 13 on how to expressly operate in a more excellent way which is an excellent spirit of love. Love is the only principle that can cause a genuine service of obedience to bring about God's exalted blessings into our lives. (Mark 12:29-31; Galatians 5:6, 13; 1 Timothy 1:5)





DOMINION2015:

DOMINION THROUGH SPEAKING WELL & WHOLE

Proverbs 12:14 "A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him." (Proverbs 13:2; 11:30)

Proverbs 15:23 "A man hath joy by the answer of his mouth: and a word spoken in due season, how good is it!"

Proverbs 16:24 "Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones."

Proverbs 6:2 "Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth."

Proverbs 18:20-21 "A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof."

A life of dominion, that is, living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life, is not a cheap life. It is one thing to ask the Lord to lift you up and position you in an exalted place of greatness, it is another thing to remain, sustain and maintain that position. It is the act of actualising and sustaining the exalted position of grace and dominion that speaking wellness to your situations and wholeness to your being comes into play. Wellness and wholeness is about all things that pertains to doing life, living godly and stimulating faith as it affects your spirit, soul and body. More also to having gracious favour with God and man in terms of one's spiritual, social, physical, emotional and mental responsibility.

Isaiah 3:10 "Say ye to the righteous, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings."

1 Thessalonians 5:23 "And the very God of peace

sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.”

Hebrews 4:12-13 *“For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.”*

Luke 2:52 *“And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.”*

Speaking wellness to your situation and wholeness to your being is more than just positive speech as people are sometimes told - be positive or speak positively; It's the act of sustaining your grace of dominion through speaking the words of grace according to the scriptures pertaining your life situations and being.

God does not operate in an empty vacuum and as such we can't communicate just positive words to Him; it has to be His words we respond back to Him, and because He is in bond in and with His word, he will act accordingly. God will only respond to His Word and not positive sayings that may seem philosophical. Such words of grace will be health - medicine - to your bones, the scriptures says and they are gracious indeed to keep one keeping on no matter what, in the realm of living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life of dominion.

Psalms 119:89 *“For ever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven.”*

Mark 13:31 *“Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.”*

Proverb 4:20-22 *“My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. 21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.”*

The Word of God, which is of grace and faith, is much

more than positive thinking or speaking. Speaking the words of grace is transmitting God's word to God because positive speaking may not have the words of life in it. It is to enact and authenticate our faith that the scripture of Isaiah 8:10 enjoins us to speak well to the one God has made righteous, because that is the position of grace wherein our dominion of living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life comes from as earlier described.

The scriptures in Proverbs 12:14, Proverbs 15:23 and Proverbs 16:24 indicate that a man shall live by the words of his lips. He will be of great joy, be fed and be satisfied and sustained by the fruit of his tongue and mouth. Proverbs 6:2 and Proverbs 18:20 say that we are snared, held captive by the words of our mouth. We can either be victorious or be a victim by the words of our lips because there is power in the words of our mouth as Christ ambassadors or representatives on earth. By the words of our lips our fruition comes to be. How powerful is that. Speaking wellness and wholeness to your plans, purposes and pursuits, instead of cursing, murmuring, complaining and blaming others about things that are not going on as brilliantly as you had intended should be ones objective.

The essence of bringing this speaking of wellness and wholeness to light is because more often than not, you see people by the words of their mouth begin to contradict even the words spoken in private before the Lord in prayers. It does not matter how many times and the length of your prayers or fasting, you must know that between the time of prayers and when the answer comes, what you say and keep saying can make or unmake the answer to your prayers - (Mark 11:20-26). Beloved, there is good and goodness in your lips, hence watch out what you say and how you say it (Romans 10:6-13). Your leverage in dominion to live the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life is engraved in the word of faith which we speak forth towards all within our domain of dominion.

Mark 11:20-26 *"And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. 21 And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. 22 And Jesus answering*

saith unto them, Have faith in God. 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. 25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.”

Romans 10:6-13 *“But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:) 7 or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) 8 But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; 9 that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. 12 For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”*

Angels, who are commissioned to minister answers to us as the heirs of salvation, can only respond to the word of the Lord. When you speak well according to the word of God they are sure to harken and respond accordingly - Hebrews 1:14 and Psalms 103:20. There is no bribery or short cut about it, one need to speak the words of grace only and nothing else; even the so called positive or motivational statement that looks like the Word and is coated in human ideology and philosophy will not move the ministering





angels. Speak the WORD only; you will then see heaven at work for you! Abraham did in the face of challenges and hopelessness and he was heard – Romans 4:17-22.

Psalms 103:19-22 “*The Lord hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all. 20 Bless the Lord, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. 21 Bless ye the Lord, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure. 22 Bless the Lord, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the Lord, O my soul.*”

Hebrews 1:14 “*Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?*”

Romans 4:17-22 “*Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, 17 (as it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. 18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. 19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara’s womb: 20 he staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; 21 and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. 22 And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness.*”

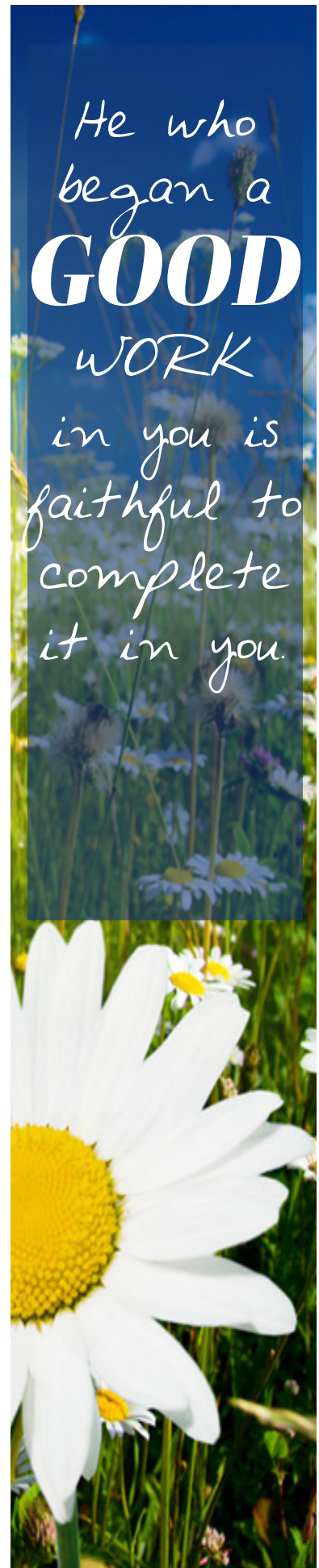
When you speak the word which the angels harken to, the Holy Spirit in us will bear witness that the word or words spoken are of God as we see in Romans 8:16-17. We are the heirs of God and children of significance and wonders. However, Isaiah 8:20 says if we therefore

Speak or someone else speaks to us and the words are not in line with the words of the Lord we should not walk in it because the light of God is not in it despite the testimony, legality or facts in it.

Don't be carried away by unfounded testimonies, facts and legality of worship designed by people to lure you into their trap in the name of prophesying and or proclaiming to you or seeing a vision about you - Psalms 37:1-7. It's good to hold firmly to The Word, It will always work to meet and solve human needs and problems!

Romans 8:16-17 *"The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together."*

Isaiah 8:18-20 *"Behold, I and the children whom the Lord hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel from the Lord of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion. 19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead? 20 To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them."*





DOMINION2015:

DOMINION THROUGH CONTINUOUS WORD STUDY, PRAYERS & FELLOWSHIP.

Dominion can only be fulfilling if there are these three acts or elements of life serve as the bedrock upon which it thrives. These three acts or elements are - Studying the Word, Prayers and Fellowship (with the Lord and brethren). The reason being that they will enhance our faith in God as we steadfastly keep on keeping on in them; and through these avenues we will make contact with people whom God may use to enhance and sustain His grace in our lives to the place of dominion: Living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life.

Jesus practices it, the Apostles maximised it and we can do it in order to be fulfilled in God's plans, purposes and pursuits in our lives. These acts are the flame that keeps us keeping on in becoming what we are saved and born to be in Christ Jesus on His REDEMPTION deeds for us.

Herein I have laid out some few scriptures to ponder on as regards the bedrock to living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life of Dominion. Kindly read, ponder and meditate through and through until the word of grace settles in your being and to strengthen you and answer your quest.

THE STUDY OF THE WORD:

Acts 6:4 "But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word."

2 Timothy 2:15 "Study to shew thyself approved

unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

Job 23:12 *"Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food." (Psalms 119)*

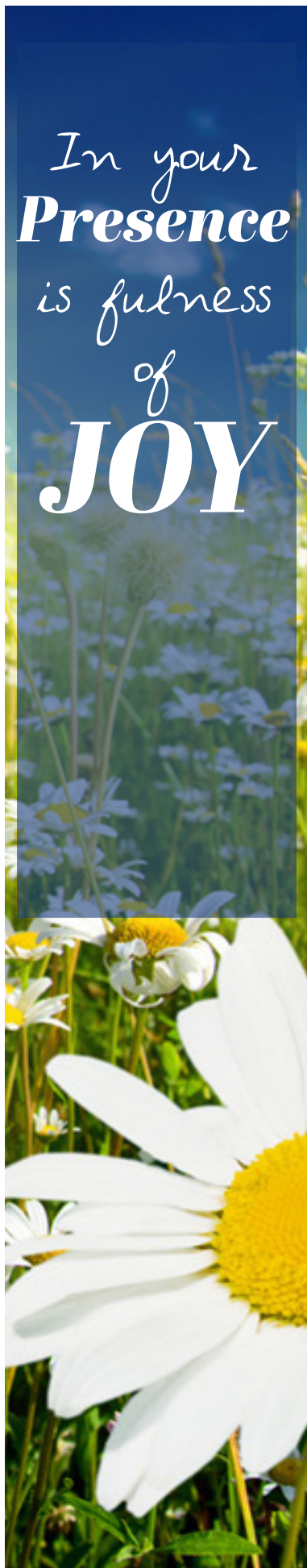

Hebrews 10:25 *"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."*

Psalms 122:1 *"I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord."*

1 Corinthians 14:26-27 *"How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying."*

Luke 4:16 *"And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read."*



JANUARY 2015:

2 Peter 1:19-21 “We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. 21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.”

John 18:37 “Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice. “

Philippians 1:21 “For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. “

Philippians 1:21 “For to me, living means opportunities for Christ, and dying—well, that’s



better yet!” (Living Bible)

1 Corinthians 9:24-27 *“Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain. 25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible. 26 I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air: 27 but I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.”*

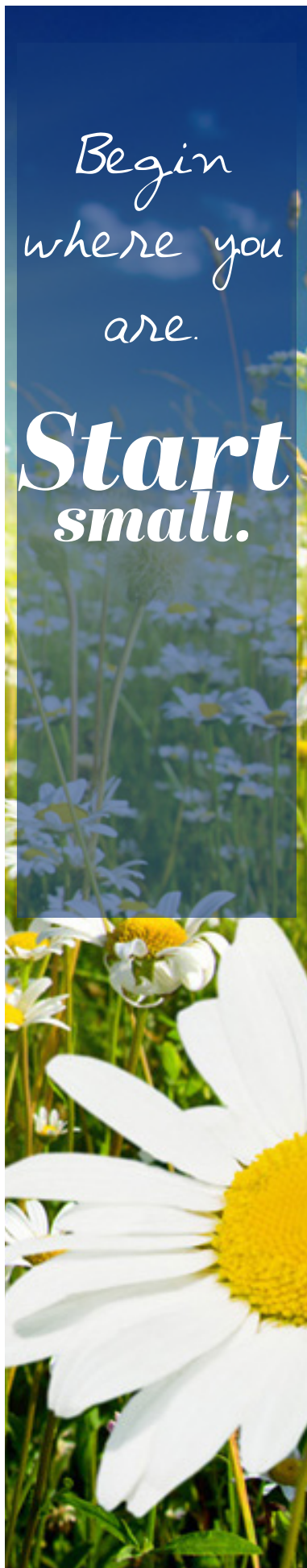
We know from 1 John 3:8 and John 18:37 that our Lord Jesus is our good indicator that living for a cause and purpose is the essence of meaningful living. It is dangerous to live without a sense of direction; not living for a purpose. It is to avert this senseless life that Apostle Paul could boldly state in Philippians 1:21 and 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 that for him, living means opportunities for Christ, and dying—well, that’s better yet. And he is not just beating the air, because all that run, run to win a prize which keeps him focused on the plans, purposes and pursuits ahead of him. Living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life in the spirit of Dominion means resolving to serve the Lord reverentially, joyfully, obediently, willingly and of choice; also means living with the understanding of times and opportunities in relation and reference to God and man.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-3 *“To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: 2 a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted; 3 a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up;”*

Ecclesiastes 8:5 *“Whoso keepeth the commandment shall feel no evil thing: and a wise man’s heart discerneth both time and judgment.”*

From Ecclesiastes 3:1-3 and Ecclesiastes 8:5 we see that every purpose in life is linked to the time. Our ability to understand and maximize the God given time to our life plans, purposes and pursuits will earnestly help us to bring the position of dominion into reality just as the children of Issachar who understood time, as enjoined in 1 Chronicles





12:32. They are fewer in number among their brethren, yet enjoyed the graciousness of dominion - living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life. When we bring our plans, purpose and pursuits to reality - we are then living a fulfilled life - Colossians 4:17.

Colossians 4:17 “*And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.*”

The Bible books of Genesis to Revelation are living proof that our God is a master of plans, purposes and pursuits. We being God's image can respond to life in the same likeness as our God. Isaiah 45:11-13 and Psalms 8:4-8 helps to affirm that God made the earth and planted man in it with a plan, purpose and pursuit in the dawn of a new beginning. Genesis 1 gives the summary of God's creation acts while Genesis 2 gives God's details of creation, and both eventually, tell us the creation story and the process and the empowering of man to have dominion at the end of creation process.

Isaiah 45:11-13 “*Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me. 12 I have made the earth, and created man upon it: I, even my hands, have stretched out the heavens, and all their host have I commanded. 13 I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, not for price nor reward, saith the Lord of hosts.*”

Psalms 8:4-8 “*When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; 4 what is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? 5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. 6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet: 7 all sheep and oxen, yea, and the beasts of the field; 8 the fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, and whatsoever*

passeth through the paths of the seas”

Living the greater, purposeful and fulfilled life is you and I accomplishing the essence of God’s plans, purposes and pursuits in our life, through our life and for our life. Until these three ways of grace are at the top of our life we are still living unfulfilled life and less in the realm of dominion. When you live the I and ME, and MYSELF life as in Luke 12:16-21 you are not yet in God’s eternal agenda for dominion. An agenda which reaches out to others, and to see the grace of God flourish in others’ lives through you because of the position of exaltation that God has brought you into.

So when you ask for better and bigger wages, a promotion at work, a bigger house, a well-furnished and spacious home, bigger cars, and envision business and entrepreneurship enlargement and expansion and more; what goes through your mind? What are the motives for asking this of God? It is when the motives and intent are wrong that wars in our members sets in and begin to show up as we see in James 4:1-4 and Luke 18:18-27. Hence, let’s set our priorities right for purposeful living at this early stage of the year in order for us to experience the grace and leverage of God to the realm of dominion - The living of the greater, purposeful and fulfilling Life.

JANUARY 2015:

BEGIN WHERE YOU ARE!

Proverbs 21:31 “*The horse is prepared against the day of battle: but safety is of the LORD.*”

Psalms 37:23-24 “*The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way. 24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the Lord upholdeth him with his hand.*”

Year 2015 is here and so is the dawn month of living the greater, purposeful and fulfilling life - Month JANUARY. It is the dawn of a new day and a fresh beginning. How one starts this January has a lot to do with what it will become through the year. The path of the good man is ordered by the Lord and a man of diligence will always end with plenty (Psalms 37:23-24). The horse is not used





on the battle ground except after it has been prepared lest there will be casualties (Proverbs 21:31). That's the reason and the need to prepare strong and armed ready for the dawn year 2015 in this month of beginning - January; to be fore warned is to be armed in order to make one's destiny exciting, rejuvenating or else the failing to plan is already a certified planning to fail!

Job 8:7 "Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase."

Zachariah 4:8-10 "Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, 9The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.

10For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth."

What is vital and important in this month of January for every one of God's people is to be humble, to start small, even if that means a fresh beginning. Don't say that you don't have enough to start. The scriptures above of Job 8:7 and Zachariah 4:8-10 say that God will reward every small beginning and it's not the size but the faith. Every seed of a small beginning has the potential to succeed, every seed can become a tree and every tree can become a forest. The scriptures further say that we should not despise the days of small beginning, for the hand that starts has the ability to complete it by God's unusual providence as He did for Job and Zerubbabel. You don't need millions to kick start that business nor hundreds to kick start that call or assignment of God upon your life. All that God needs is simple obedience and faithfulness to the start with the little if need be - Luke 16:10-12; He will then bring about the increase on your behalf - ***1 Corinthians 3:6-10.***

"I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither is he that planteth

anything, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase. 8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour. 9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. 10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise master builder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon."

Luke 16:10-12 *"He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. 11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? 12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?"*

We serve the God of increase, hence in Psalms 115:9-16, the three groups mentioned there - House of Israel, House of Aaron and the house of those that fear the Lord - together are people of covenant. For that, God has determined to increase and blessed them along with their children more and more. When you faithfully begin small, you open up avenues of increase in other areas of your life and much more to posterity.

Psalms 115:9-16 *"O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. The LORD hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. He will bless them that fear the LORD, both small and great. The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children. Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth. The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD'S: but the earth hath he given to the children of men."*

Job in the scripture lost all through trials, but began





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small and was later multiplied with increase - Job 42:12-17. In the same way, our Lord Jesus grew with increase in all dimensions from His birth in the manger to the place of being Lord of lords - Luke 2:52. I believe if you can humbly start, even if it's small, it will surely bring forth a great increase for you in the course of time with an exalted opportunities for the unusual goodness of God in 2015.

Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man."

Job 42:12-17 "So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses. He had also seven sons and three daughters. And he called the name of the first, Jemima; and the name of the second, Kezia; and the name of the third, Kerenhappuch. And in all the land were no women found so fair as the daughters of Job: and their father gave them inheritance among their brethren. After this lived Job an hundred and forty years, and saw his sons, and his sons' sons, even four generations. So Job died, being old and full of days. "

Dear AFD recipient, don't just stay idle, murmuring and complaining and blaming others at the beginning of the year 2015; if you can just start with the available small opportunity, God will bless and increase you. A little time to pray, read and study your Bible can open up great avenues of revelation, inspiration and empowerment. Your little act of kindness, sharing faith, giving or tithing can create other open doors and stop the devourer. Your little investment of time or other resources in that business and relationship can turn your history.

Therefore, in JANUARY of 2015, as a dawn month of purposeful living, which is an avenue into a year of great inspiration, revelation and empowerment for a new beginning, don't take things for granted. Don't eat up your little seed; sow it into that given cause(s) by faith, to that which God has put in your spirit, for there your destiny may be shaped. A little start to learn how

to forgive and make peace will bring forth healing and unbelievable miracles. Make wise plans and escape from the bondage of buy today and pay greater tomorrow. Start saving and investing small and make progress to your destiny of colourful living to end the year saying indeed the good Lord has brought me to a place of EXALTATION as a done deed in His Word - Ephesians 2:4-10.

FINALLY: DOMINION2015 - LET'S DECLARE IT!

DOMINION2015: CALLING THOSE THINGS THAT BE NOT!

2015 is pregnant and is here to give birth to all sorts. Only God definitely knows the end from the beginning of year 2015.

But if you believe in your goals as God has always believed in His, you need to steadily do what Bible faith people did to cause their goal to come to pass. (Romans 4:16-21).

saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."

JEREMIAH 29:11

The Philistines were enemies of the chosen people of God - Israel. Israel was always meant to have God fight for them. They were never meant to fight in their own strength. Daily this Philistine army came out for 40 days, over & over again to taunt the Israelites to fight them. The Israelites they came out and feared and trembled - daily.

Goliath defied & stood against God & His people and the people were scared.

"Come on - bring someone to fight me. If he wins we'll be your subjects - if I do, you will serve us."

He was just saying that, they didn't for one minute think they could - after all - he was this menacing giant. He had it all planned out, the Israelites could not possibly defeat them which means that these Israelites will serve us for ever. He had a plan.

When David came up and put his trust in God Almighty - Eph 6:10 - he

knew that God was able to give him the strength & grace to face Goliath. He may not even have realised how it would happen ... but God....! David may have been the unlikely vessel who would fulfil this mission of winning the battle against the Philistines. 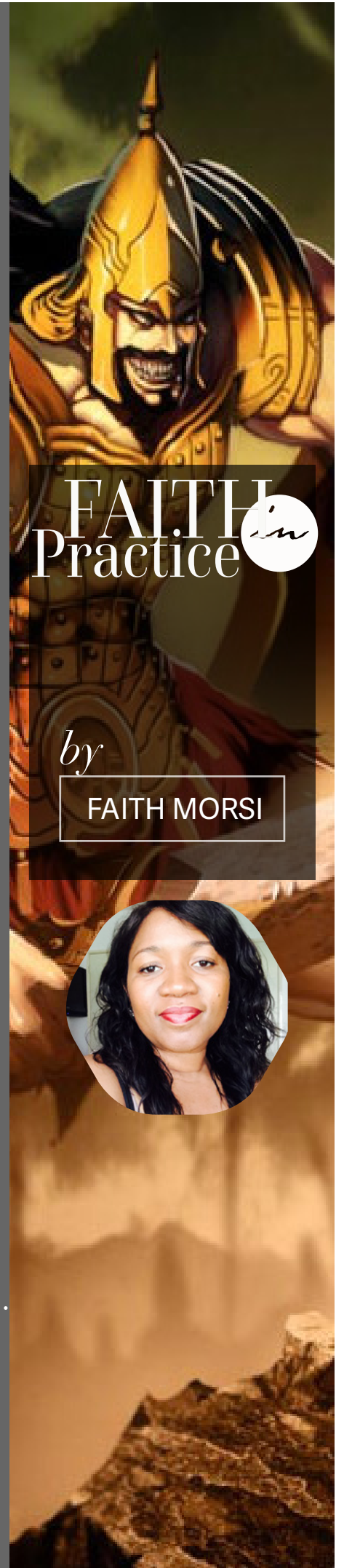
Some may trust in horses, some may trust in chariots - but we will trust in the name of our God. (Psalm 20:6-8)

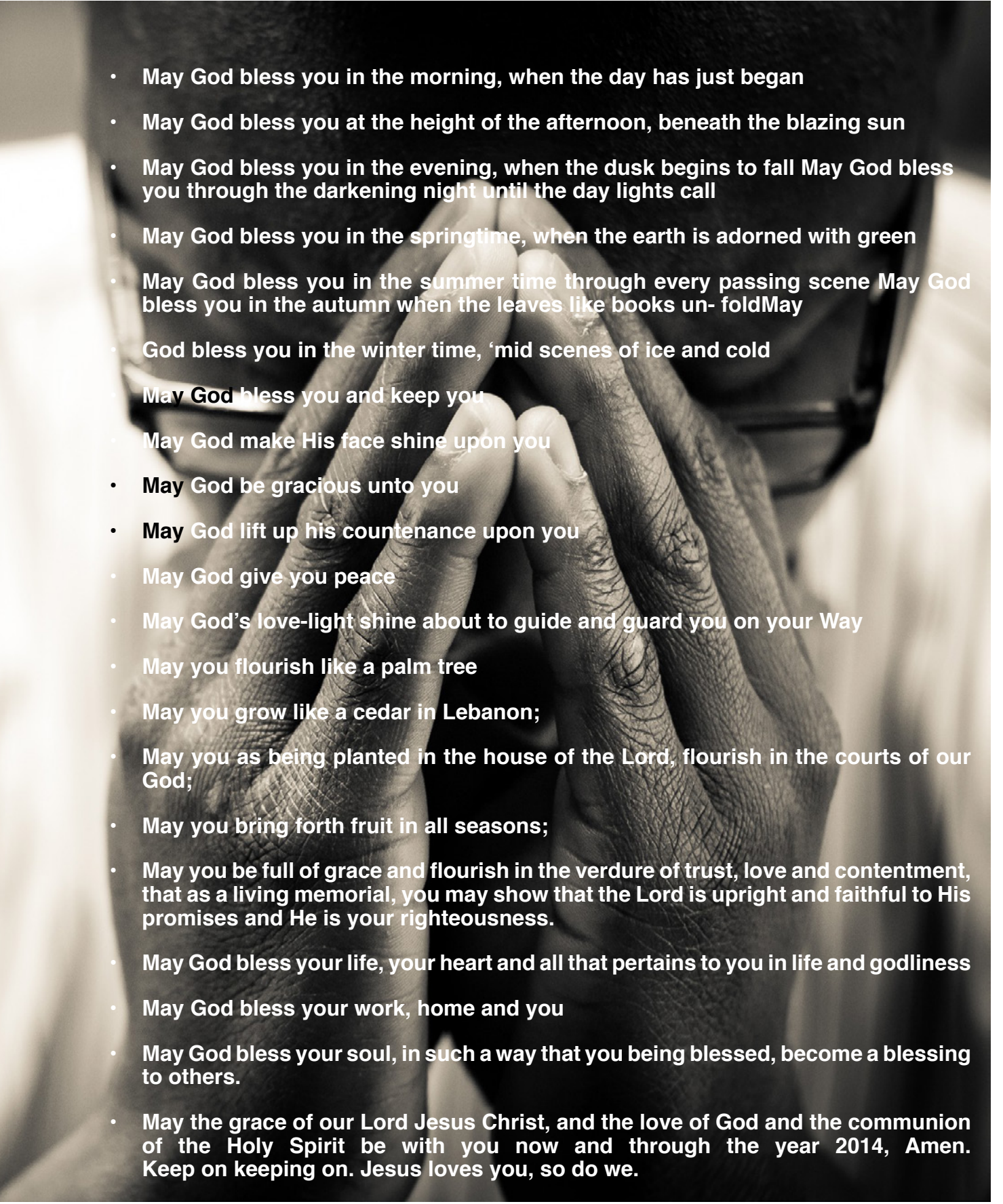
